






Proxemics

 People surround themselves with a "bubble" of personal space(Edward Hall, 1966)




Intimate distance: $0 \sim 1.5 \text{ feet}(0.45 \text{ m})$

Personal distance: 1.5 ~ 4 feet(1.2 m)

Social distance: 4 ~ 12 feet(3.6 m)

Public distance: more than 12 feet





WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO HAVE A SAFE SPACE?


A place or environment in which a person or category of people can feel confident that they will not be exposed to discrimination, criticism, harassment, or any other emotional or physical harm.

The Mountains

- Mount Sinai: Moses receives the 10 commandments (Gen 19, 20,24)
- **Mount Zion**: City of David established here. Solomon's temple built here (2 Sam 51:10)
- Mount Carmel: Elijah calls on God for power over the prophets of Baal (1 Kings 18)
- Sermon on the Mount by Jesus
- Mount of the Transfiguration: Jesus meets Moses and Elijah
- Mount of Olives: Jesus prays here before his crucifixion and ascends to heaven also from here (Luke 22:39-49).




1. Safe spaces are sacred spaces.


- The church is a safe space for sinners but not for sin.

2. Safe spaces are relational spaces.


- Some of us in our season of life need to feel like we are in a vibrant City of God space.

3. Safe spaces are protected spaces.

- The **Garden of Eden** was meant to be protected from the evil One. Adam should have driven out the snake when confronted with temptation. He should have cleansed the Garden as it was a temple.
- Jerusalem was meant to be guarded from danger externally and within. Instead the people allowed idolatry to flourish.
- By His sacrificial death on the cross, Jesus offered up His body to cleanse the temple of it's sins and guilt. Believers are now that temple of the Holy Spirit. As a body of priestly gardeners and city builders we likewise protect the church.

4. Safe spaces are receiving and sending spaces.

- The Garden of Eden was to receive new population and be extended by worship, obedience and cultivation to make the rest of the world into a paradise (Gen 1:28).
- Believers were sent to all major Roman cities to created safe spaces for worship, obedience and city building. To redeem broken cities with the Gospel starting with Jerusalem (Acts 1:8).



To some extent, people think only major cities matter, or that it is only worthwhile to live in major cities. This is the younger generation's dream. To a certain extent they are right. But the gospel tells us the church is the biggest city in the world. The church is the real "Beijing, Shanghai, and Guangzhou." The church is the capital of human souls. The gospel made a group of apostles from the backward province of Galilee into the center of the new world. Our churches are becoming crowded with middle class professionals. The gospel needs to enter the city more deeply. It must enter the drains, enter in with the petitioners and the marginalized peoples.

He is calling you to respond to him, to respond to the city of God, to build the city of God in your own city, to be a doorkeeper in his city. Let this become the biggest dream of your life, the calling that God has given you.
