
HUMILITY -WORD DID NOT EXIST BEFORE NT TIMES


PECKING ORDER

- Understand each are given different proportions of faith hence we do not compare but seriously consider the proportion our own faith and talents and be responsible and thankful for them and not allow them to puff us up



ARISTOTLE GENTLENESS (MEEKNESS)

• The golden mean

 'the mean between being too angry and never being angry at all'

• 'the absence of the disposition to assert personal rights, either in the presence of God or of men GENTLENESS OF THE STRONG, WHOSE STRENGTH IS UNDER CONTROL. IT IS THE QUALITY OF A STRONG PERSONALITY WHO IS NEVERTHELESS MASTER OF HIMSELF AND THE SERVANT OF OTHERS



Conscious exercise of self control..exhibiting conscious choice of gentleness as opposed to use of power for retaliation



Taming of animals

- 'the meek man thinks as little of his personal claims, as the humble man of his personal merits'.

MOSES

- Numbers 12:3 (ESV) Now the man Moses was <u>very meek</u>, more than all people who were on the face of the earth.
- Exodus 32:19-20 (ESV) And as soon as he came near the camp and saw the calf and the dancing, Moses' anger burned hot, and he threw the tablets out of his hands and broke them at the foot of the mountain. 20 He took the calf that they had made and burned it with fire and ground it to powder and scattered it on the water and made the people of Israel drink it.


