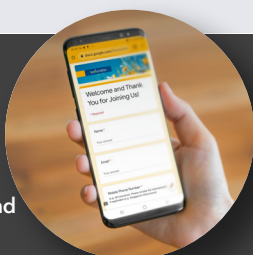
I wonder how many of us actually give thought to Palm Sunday.

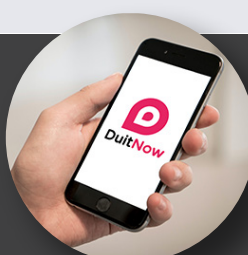

But Palm Sunday?

When Jesus rode into Jerusalem on a donkey that day, his disciples gave him a rousing welcome, shouting, "Hosanna" (John 12:13) which means "save us". Waving palm branches with their hands and spreading their cloaks before him, they fully expected Jesus to come and free them from the Roman oppressors and reign as their king. Having seen the miracles Jesus had performed, who could blame them for looking forward to the start of a glorious time.

After all, this was prophesied in Zechariah 9:

*9 Rejoice greatly, Daughter Zion!
Shout, Daughter Jerusalem!
See, your king comes to you,
righteous and victorious,
lowly and riding on a donkey, on a colt,
the foal of a donkey.
10 I will take away the chariots from Ephraim
and the warhorses from Jerusalem,
and the battle bow will be broken.
He will proclaim peace to the nations.
His rule will extend from sea to sea
and from the River to the ends of the earth.*

But Jesus knew he had come to Jerusalem to die. And, before a horrible death on the cross, he also knew he had to suffer terrible beatings, shame, and rejection by the very people he came to save. Being fully human, Jesus knew the pain he would have to endure. And perhaps even more painful to him was to see the grief of his mother. The women who truly loved Jesus also suffered when they saw him battered and broken, hanging on the cross.

As God, Jesus could have called down fire from heaven to vanquish his enemies and become king, averting all the pain. But he also knew that would not reconcile man to God. And that was why he went to the cross. He did it for you and me.

In our busyness with life, we oftentimes take our Lord Jesus for granted, forgetting that being fully human, Jesus could have struggled emotionally for a whole week. Perhaps that was why Jesus prayed for the cup of suffering to be taken away from him if God was willing.

Let us pause this Palm Sunday and reflect on Jesus' tremendous sacrifice that was necessary to reconcile us to the Father and, "in view of God's mercy, to offer {our} bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is {our} true and proper worship." (Romans 12:1) [©]
