FOCUS

Currently, CREST serves in countries across Asia and takes on the mantle to train more relief volunteers in Malaysia and beyond. CREST has also moved beyond mere active emergency response into mitigation (where possible), rehabilitation, and even reconstruction with the ultimate goal of impacting and transforming communities with dignity and self-reliance.

WHERE WE HAVE SERVED & WHAT WE HAVE DONE

Since its establishment in 1998, CREST has trained and sent more than 1338 volunteers from all walks of life to 20 countries on 166 mission trips to provide humanitarian assistance in the form of medical aid, food, water, clothing, and shelter to victims of natural disasters and crisis situations. Working with partners who share the same vision, many unreached groups who often do not receive mainline media coverage have been helped.

In Malaysia, CREST has been at the frontline for tsunami, flood, and pandemic crisis response. When disaster hits, CREST is set up to mobilize quickly to meet the immediate needs of those affected, with the support and backing from partners and local churches. Two examples of this would be the flood relief efforts in Sri Muda, Mentakab, and Temerloh in January 2022, as well as the Covid-19 quarantine and treatment center (PKRCS) in 2H 2021, which FBC Subang Jaya participated in through logistics support as well as financial contribution. More than 200 families impacted by floods and 1000 Covid-19 patients were served through these initiatives.

FUNDING

CREST is a non-profit organization where funds for operations and projects come entirely from the contribution of individuals, churches, and organizations. Our funds are managed in the account of Crisis Relief Services & Training Berhad, a company limited by guarantee and constituted under the Malaysian Companies Act 1965. All donations to CREST are duly receipted and accounted for. Our accounts are audited annually and open for inspection.

KEY ACTIVITIES GOING FORWARD

CREST would like to engage churches in supporting and providing training on a regular basis in this area. We believe that the fruits of this endeavor would be that church members will be more knowledgeable and resilient towards disaster and the Malaysian church will be better equipped to mobilize and respond in times of disasters within and even beyond her own immediate community.

For CREST to be able to accomplish all these we need the active and tangible support of Malaysian Churches in the following areas:

1. **Physically** – identifying and nominating volunteers who can be trained and ready/able to respond in times of need.
2. **Spiritually** – Prayer coverage for CREST and her staff in all her projects and activities.
3. **Financially** – Supporting and partnering with CREST so that she can fulfill her calling and role.
