

What About

KVBC NEX+GEN

KVBC's NextGen is a 4-day camp/conference which aims to raise up, equip and encourage the next generation of Christian leaders to grow in godliness and to teach the bible faithfully. Delegates will have the opportunity to write and present a Bible study to their respective 'strand' groups.

When I was first introduced to KVBC's NextGen in 2018, two

thoughts came to mind:-

- Who is this conference for?
- Why would anyone want to stress themselves in preparing 'study' materials in a short span of 4 days?

I did not give much thought to it but simply chose to shelve it, thinking that this sort of camp/conference is not suitable for me. A year later when attending another



conference by KVBC, I was again introduced to NextGen. I've heard of it twice now, and I still have the same two thoughts in my mind but this time, I also add another excuse, 'I'm done with my studies and I should focus on pursuing my career. Any other thing comes next'. So again, I shelved it.

Then came 2020 and the pandemic - somehow I'm employed (thanks be to God for that!) and, I was again introduced to NextGen (the third time in 3 years). This time, I thought to myself, surely there must be a purpose on why this 'thing' keeps being reintroduced again and again into my life, and with some encouragement from Pastor Joash, a few of the Salt of Subang (SOS) youth leaders also signing-up and some spare work leaves to burn, I took the chance and signed up for the conference (as it was at the start of the pandemic, it was an online camp/conference instead of their usual physical camp).

Did I regret my decision to sign-up for NextGen? No, not at all, I quickly learnt that the main objective of NextGen is to help equip and train young Christian leaders to grow in godliness by first understanding the importance of His word and how to read the bible well.

Yes, there's still the assignment of producing a Bible study in 4 days which can be quite daunting and stressful (we had some delegates that pull out all-nighters to complete their study!) but I guess that's the fun part about the strand groups, being able to share and struggle with one another about His word.

Personally, the assignment of preparing a Bible study really helps me understand the perspective of others and how their train of thought works. Not only in understanding scripture but also how they choose to package and deliver God's word to their respective ministries. It was then that I realised how organic God's word is, even with the whole strand group going through the same passage of scripture, each individual can produce a unique Bible study which relates to the ministry that they serve in. I recall in the second conference I joined in 2021, my group consisted of people serving from kids ministry all the way up to young adults. And even though the ministries that we serve in were different based on demographics, God's word ultimately speaks to us; albeit a revelation of His character or a reminder of His good promise to us.



So, who is this conference for? Anyone who wants to learn how to read His word well. Why would anyone want to stress themselves in preparing 'study' materials in a short span of 4 days? I guess that's something for you to experience. I can tell you that I don't currently prepare any studies in the short span of 4 days, but the practice of making a study during the NextGen conference is to show us that we are able to read, understand, package and deliver God's word to our respective ministries.
