



Our Home strives to provide a safe, loving, and nurturing environment for the children where they experience the transformative power of our Lord's love. The name `First Light' signifies a new `Dawn' of Hope and Blessings in the lives of the girls.

Some of our girls study at FBC Covenant Christian Center (CCC), others at national schools. The eldest has just finished her Form 5 SPM exams and currently helps out as an intern at Church.

Some attend the Tamil Service and some with Kairos. In addition, some attend Sunday School, or Youth or the Boys' Brigade.

The home is run by Ms Esther, the Home Mother, and assisted by Ms Marry, the cook.

Our girls enjoy the occasional outings, swimming, ice skating, movies, etc. A few Life Groups have visited and brought cheers to them with interesting events like soap making, etc.

We currently have a pool of amazing volunteer tuition teachers. As the Girls' ages and levels of education vary, they have personalized and individualized tuition, on a one-to-one basis, in their various subjects. They also have arts and crafts classes, etc. Special thanks to all our teachers.

Nevertheless, we are looking for more volunteer teachers and also teachers to teach computer skills and living skills like cooking, baking, sewing, etc. Please do join us in His Ministry and give our precious and priceless time. In anticipation of your generosity, we would say a big Thank You.
