

Book of Ezekiel

Lesson 9

11:17Therefore say, 'Thus says the Lord GOD: I will gather you from the peoples and assemble you out of the countries where you have been scattered, and I will give you the land of Israel.' ... ¹⁹And I will give them one heart, and a new spirit I will put within them. I will remove the heart of stone from their flesh and give them a heart of flesh, ²⁰that they may walk in my statutes and keep my rules and obey them. And they shall be my people, and I will be their God.

Jeremiah 32:³⁹I will give them one heart and one way, that they may fear me forever, for their own good and the good of their children after them. ⁴⁰I will make with them an everlasting covenant ... And I will put the fear of me in their hearts, that they may not turn from me.

Psalms 86:^{11b}Teach me your way, Lord, that I may rely on your faithfulness; give me an undivided heart, that I may fear your name.

16:⁶⁰yet I will remember my covenant with you in the days of your youth, and I will establish for you an everlasting covenant.... ⁶²I will establish my covenant with you, and you shall know that I am the LORD.

17:22 Thus says the Lord GOD: “I myself will take a sprig from the lofty top of the cedar ... and I myself will plant it on a high and lofty mountain ... ²³ ... of Israel ..., that it may bear branches and produce fruit and become a noble cedar. And under it will dwell every kind of bird ...
24 And all the trees of the field shall know that I am the LORD; ... I am the LORD; I have spoken, and I will do it.”

20:33“As I live, declares the Lord GOD, surely with a mighty hand and an outstretched arm and with wrath poured out I will be king over you. ³⁴I will bring you out from the peoples and gather you out of the countries where you are scattered, with a mighty hand and an outstretched arm, and with wrath poured out. ³⁵And I will bring you into the wilderness of the peoples, and there I will enter into judgment with you face to face....
⁴⁴And you shall know that I am the LORD, when I deal with you for my name’s sake,

28:24“And for the house of Israel there shall be no more a brier to prick or a thorn to hurt them among all their neighbors who have treated them with contempt. Then they will know that I am the Lord GOD. ²⁵“Thus says the Lord GOD: When I gather the house of Israel from the peoples among whom they are scattered, and manifest my holiness in them in the sight of the nations, then they shall dwell in their own land that I gave to my servant Jacob... ²⁶... securely, when I execute judgments upon all their neighbors who have treated them with contempt. Then they will know that I am the LORD their God.”

34:15 I myself will be the shepherd of my sheep, and I myself will make them lie down, declares the Lord GOD.... 23 And I will set up over them one shepherd, my servant David, and he shall feed them: he shall feed them and be their shepherd. 24 And I, the LORD, will be their God, and my servant David shall be prince among them. I am the LORD; I have spoken. 25 "I will make with them a covenant of peace and banish wild beasts from the land, so that they may dwell securely in the wilderness and sleep in the woods.

36:⁶Therefore prophesy concerning the land of Israel, and say ... ⁸“But you, O mountains of Israel, shall shoot forth your branches and yield your fruit to my people Israel, for they will soon come home. ¹⁰And I will multiply people on you, the whole house of Israel, all of it....¹¹... And I will cause you to be inhabited as in your former times, and will do more good to you than ever before. Then you will know that I am the LORD. ¹²I will let people walk on you, even my people Israel. And they shall possess you, and you shall be their inheritance, and you shall no longer bereave them of children.

36:22“Therefore say to the house of Israel, Thus says the Lord GOD: It is not for your sake, O house of Israel, that I am about to act, but for the sake of my holy name, which you have profaned among the nations to which you came. ²³And I will vindicate the holiness of my great name, which has been profaned among the nations, and which you have profaned among them. And the nations will know that I am the LORD, declares the Lord GOD, when through you I vindicate my holiness before their eyes. ²⁴I will take you from the nations and gather you from all the countries and bring you into your own land.

36:²⁵I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you shall be clean from all your uncleannesses, and from all your idols I will cleanse you. ²⁶And I will give you a new heart, and a new spirit I will put within you. And I will remove the heart of stone from your flesh and give you a heart of flesh. ²⁷And I will put my Spirit within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes and be careful to obey my rules. ²⁸You shall dwell in the land that I gave to your fathers, and you shall be my people, and I will be your God...³⁵And they will say, 'This land that was desolate has become like the garden of Eden.

18:³⁰...Repent and turn from all your transgression... ³¹... and make yourselves a new heart and a new spirit!

Deuteronomy 10:¹⁶ Circumcise therefore the foreskin of your heart, and be no longer stubborn.

30:¹ “And when all these things come upon you, ... and you call them to mind among all the nations where the LORD your God has driven you,² and return to the LORD your God ... and obey his voice in all that I command you today, with all your heart and with all your soul,³ then the LORD your God will restore your fortunes and have mercy on you, and he will gather you again from ... where the LORD your God has scattered you....⁶ And the LORD your God will circumcise your heart and the heart of your offspring, so that you will love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul, that you may live.

Jeremiah 24:⁷I will give them a heart to know that I am the LORD, and they shall be my people and I will be their God, for they shall return to me with their whole heart.

31:³¹“Behold, ... I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and the house of Judah, ³²not like the covenant that I made with their fathers ... when I took them ... out of the land of Egypt ³³For ... I will put my law within them, and I will write it on their hearts. And I will be their God, and they shall be my people. ³⁴And no longer shall each one teach his neighbor and each his brother, saying, ‘Know the LORD,’ for they shall all know me, from the least of them to the greatest, declares the LORD. For I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sin no more.”

Genesis 17:⁷And I will establish my covenant between me and you and your offspring after you throughout their generations for an everlasting covenant, to be God to you and to your offspring after you. ⁸And I will give to you and to your offspring after you ... all the land of Canaan, for an everlasting possession, and I will be their God.”

Exodus 6:⁷I will take you to be my people, and I will be your God, and you shall know that I am the LORD your God, who has brought you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians. ⁸I will bring you into the land that I swore to give to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob. I will give it to you for a possession. I am the LORD.”

37:²¹... Thus says the Lord GOD: Behold, I will take the people of Israel ... and bring them to their own land. ²²And I will make them one nation ... on the mountains of Israel ... ²³... and they shall be my people, and I will be their God ... ²⁵... and David my servant shall be their prince forever. ²⁶I will make a covenant of peace with them. It shall be an everlasting covenant with them. And I ... will set my sanctuary in their midst forevermore. ²⁷My dwelling place shall be with them, and I will be their God, and they shall be my people. ²⁸Then the nations will know that I am the LORD who sanctifies Israel, when my sanctuary is in their midst forevermore.”

38:14“Therefore, son of man, prophesy, and say to Gog, Thus says the Lord GOD: On that day when my people Israel are dwelling securely, will you not know it? ¹⁵You will come from your place out of the uttermost parts of the north, you and many peoples with you, all of them riding on horses, a great host, a mighty army. ¹⁶You will come up against my people Israel, like a cloud covering the land. In the latter days I will bring you against my land, that the nations may know me, when through you, O Gog, I vindicate my holiness before their eyes.... ²³So I will show my greatness and my holiness and make myself known in the eyes of many nations. Then they will know that I am the LORD.

39:7“And my holy name I will make known in the midst of my people Israel, and I will not let my holy name be profaned anymore. And the nations shall know that I am the LORD, the Holy One in Israel....²¹“And I will set my glory among the nations, and all the nations shall see my judgment that I have executed ... on them.²²The house of Israel shall know that I am the LORD their God, from that day forward.²³“And the nations shall know that the house of Israel went into captivity for their iniquity, because they dealt so treacherously with me that I hid my face from them and gave them into the hand of their adversaries.”

39:²⁸Then they will know that I am the LORD their God, for ... I will gather them to their own land²⁹ ... I will pour out my Spirit upon the people of Israel, declares the Sovereign Lord.”

37:¹⁴I will put my Spirit in you and you will live, and I will settle you in your own land. 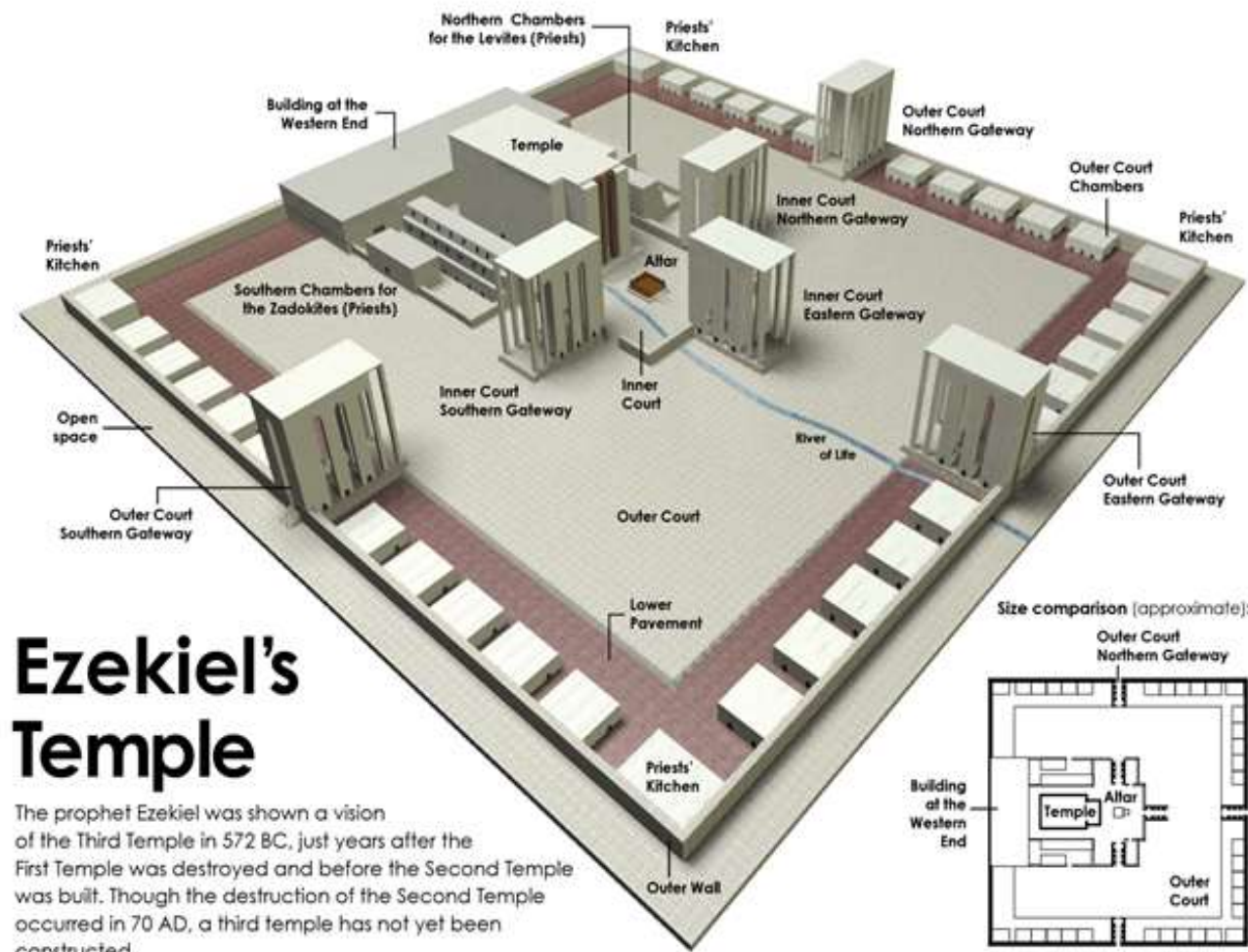

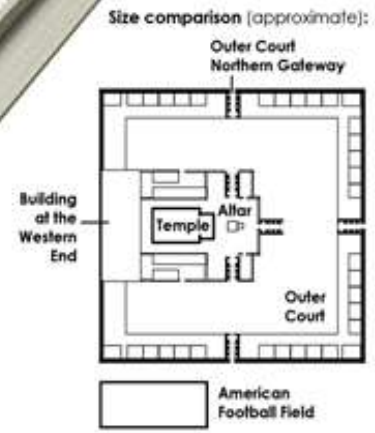

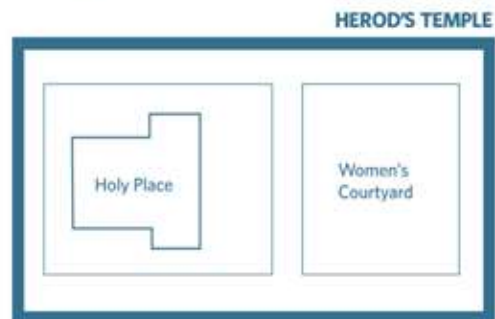
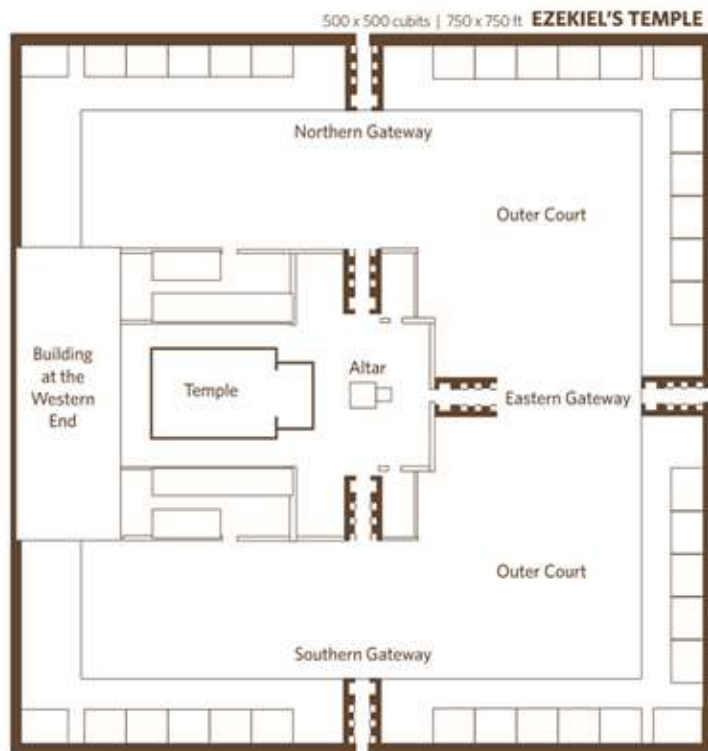
Ezekiel's Temple

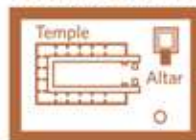

SOLOMON'S TEMPLE



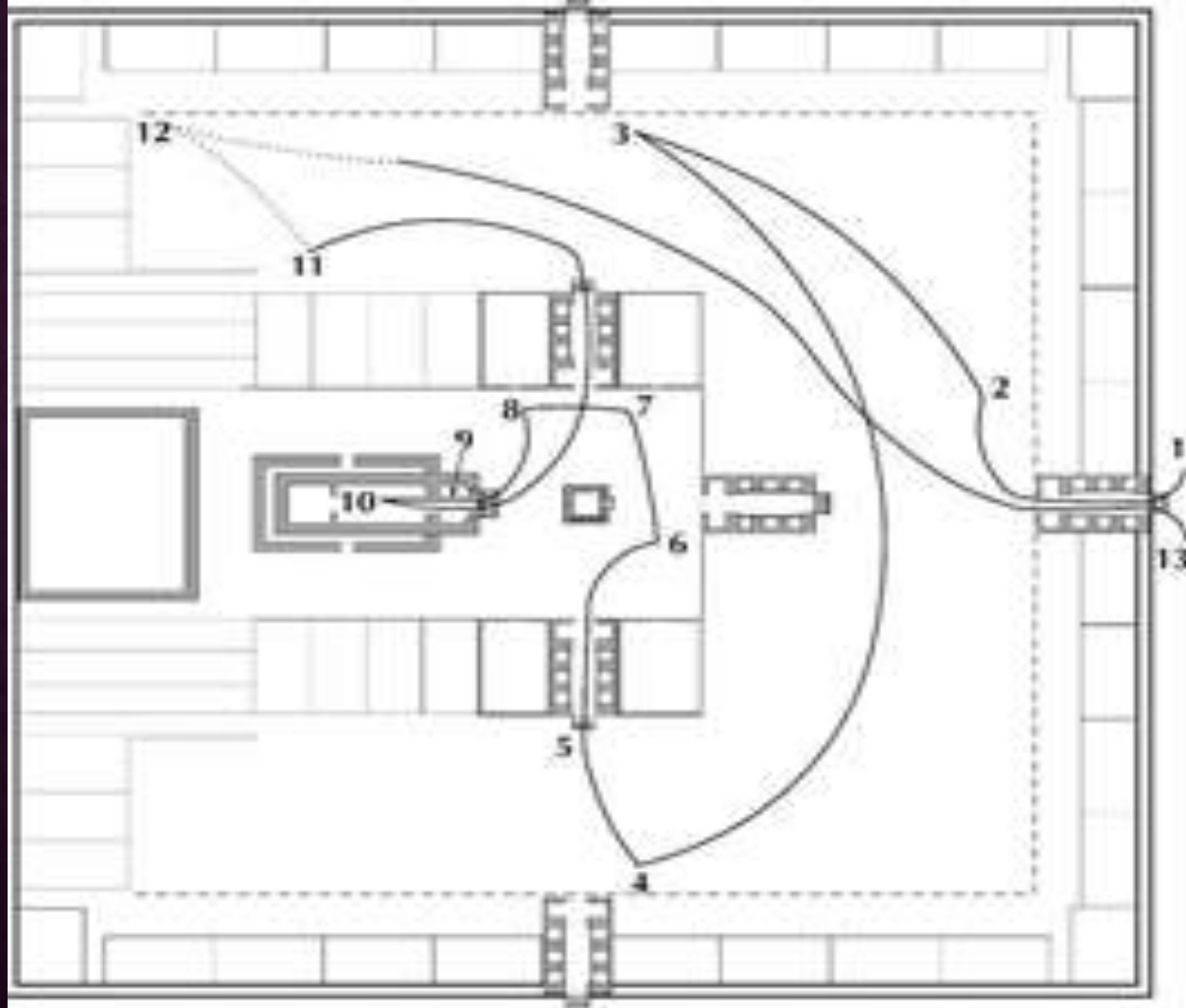
COURT OF THE TABERNACLE

43:¹Then he led me to the gate, the gate facing toward the east; ²and behold, the glory of the God of Israel was coming from the way of the east. And His voice was like the sound of many waters; and the earth shone with His glory. ³And *it was* like the appearance of the vision which I saw, like the vision which I saw when He came to destroy the city. And the visions *were* like the vision which I saw by the river Chebar; and I fell on my face. ⁴And the glory of the LORD came into the house by the way of the gate facing toward the east. ⁵And the Spirit lifted me up and brought me into the inner court; and behold, the glory of the LORD filled the house.

43:⁷He said to me, “Son of man, *this is* the place of My throne and the place of the soles of My feet, where I will dwell among the sons of Israel forever. And the house of Israel will not again defile My holy name ... ⁹ ... and I will dwell among them forever.

37:²⁵“They will live on the land ... forever; and David My servant will be their prince forever. ²⁶“I will make a covenant of peace with them; it will be an everlasting covenant with them. And I will ... set My sanctuary in their midst forever. ²⁷“My dwelling place also will be with them; and I will be their God, and they will be My people. ²⁸“And the nations will know that I am the LORD who sanctifies Israel, when My sanctuary is in their midst forever.”””

Revelation 21:¹Then I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away, and the sea was no more. ²And I saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. ³And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, “Behold, the dwelling place of God is with man. He will dwell with them, and they will be his people, and God himself will be with them as their God. ⁴He will wipe away every tear from their eyes, and death shall be no more, neither shall there be mourning, nor crying, nor pain anymore, for the former things have passed away.”

43:10“As for you, son of man, describe the temple to the house of Israel, that they may be ashamed of their iniquities; and let them measure the plan. ¹¹“If they are ashamed of all that they have done, make known to them the design of the house, its structure, its exits, its entrances, all its designs, all its statutes, and all its laws. And write *it* in their sight, so that they may observe its whole design and all its statutes and do them.

43:12“This is the law of the house: its entire area on the top of the mountain all around *shall be* most holy. Behold, this is the law of the house....

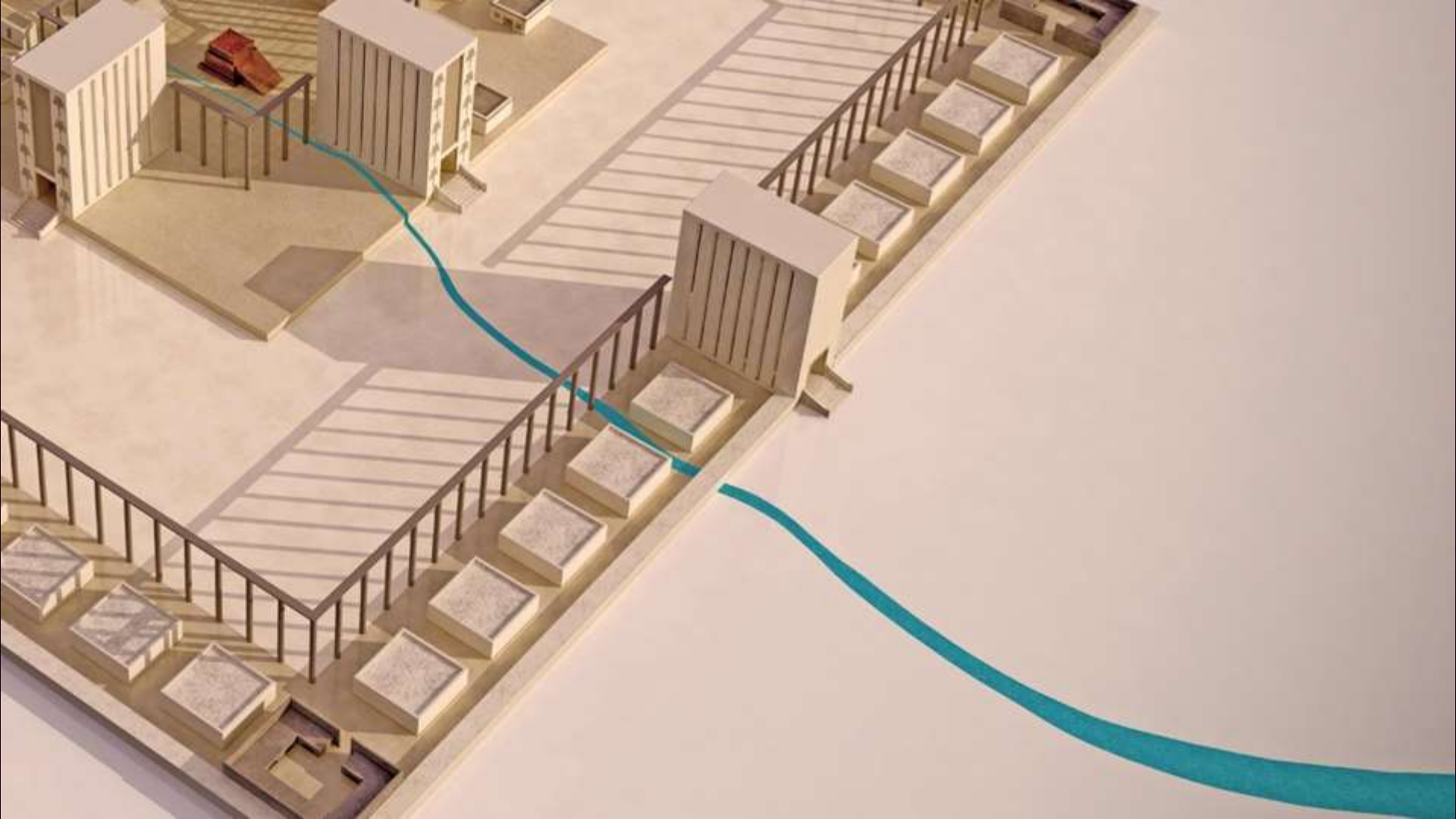
18And He said to me, “Son of man, thus says the Lord GOD, ‘These are the statutes for the altar on the day it is built, to offer burnt offerings on it and to sprinkle blood on it.... **20**’You shall take some of its blood and put it on its four horns and on the four corners of the ledge and on the border round about; thus you shall cleanse it and make atonement for it.

44:¹Then He brought me back by the way of the outer gate of the sanctuary, which faces the east; and it was shut. ²The LORD said to me, “This gate shall be shut; it shall not be opened, and no one shall enter by it, for the LORD God of Israel has entered by it; therefore it shall be shut. ³“As for the prince, he shall sit in it as prince to eat bread before the LORD; he shall enter by way of the porch of the gate and shall go out by the same way.”

45:13“This is the offering that you shall offer: a sixth of an ephah from a homer of wheat ... ¹⁵ and one sheep from *each* flock of two hundred ... for a grain offering, for a burnt offering and for peace offerings, to make atonement for them,” declares the Lord GOD. ¹⁶“All the people of the land shall give to this offering for the prince in Israel. ¹⁷“It shall be the prince’s part to provide the burnt offerings, the grain offerings and the drink offerings, at the feasts, on the new moons and on the sabbaths, at all the appointed feasts of the house of Israel; he shall provide the sin offering, the grain offering, the burnt offering and the peace offerings, to make atonement for the house of Israel.”

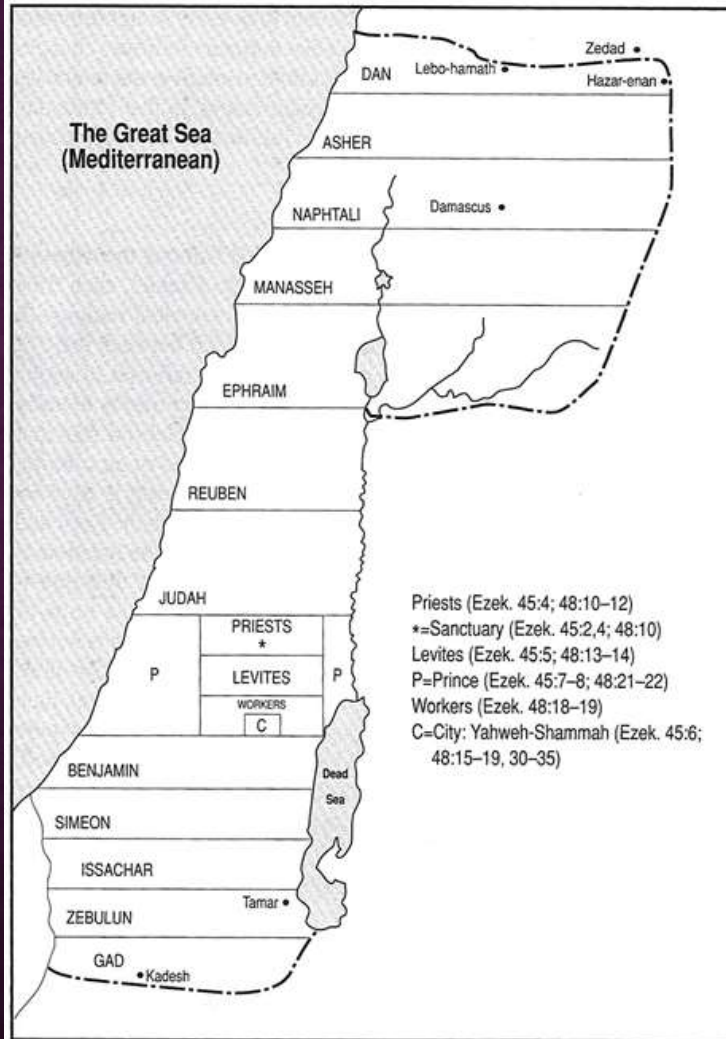
45:21 "In the first *month*, on the fourteenth day of the month, you shall have the Passover, a feast of seven days; unleavened bread shall be eaten. 22 "On that day the prince shall provide for himself and all the people of the land a bull for a sin offering. 23 "During the seven days of the feast he shall provide as a burnt offering to the LORD seven bulls and seven rams without blemish on every day of the seven days, and a male goat daily for a sin offering.

Hebrews 7:¹¹ Now if perfection was through the Levitical priesthood (for on the basis of it the people received the Law), what further need *was there* for another priest to arise according to the order of Melchizedek, and not be designated according to the order of Aaron? ¹²For when the priesthood is changed, of necessity there takes place a change of law also. ¹³For the one concerning whom these things are spoken belongs to another tribe, from which no one has officiated at the altar.



47:7... I saw on the bank of the river very many trees on the one side and on the other... 8... “This water flows toward the eastern region and goes down into the Arabah, and enters the sea ... 9 ... For this water goes there, that the waters of the sea may become fresh; so everything will live where the river goes... 12 And on the banks, on both sides of the river, there will grow all kinds of trees for food. Their leaves will not wither, nor their fruit fail, but they will bear fresh fruit every month, because the water for them flows from the sanctuary. Their fruit will be for food, and their leaves for healing.”

Revelation 22:¹Then the angel showed me the river of the water of life, bright as crystal, flowing from the throne of God and of the Lamb ²through the middle of the street of the city; also, on either side of the river, the tree of life with its twelve kinds of fruit, yielding its fruit each month. The leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations.

47:21“You are to divide this land among yourselves according to the tribes of Israel. **22**You will allot it as an inheritance for yourselves and for the aliens residing among you, who have fathered children among you. You will treat them like native-born Israelites; along with you, they will be allotted an inheritance among the tribes of Israel. **23**In whatever tribe the alien resides, you will assign his inheritance there.” This is the declaration of the Lord God.

48:30“These shall be the exits of the city: On the north side, ... ³¹three gates, the gate of Reuben, the gate of Judah, and the gate of Levi, the gates of the city being named after the tribes of Israel. ³²On the east side, ... three gates, the gate of Joseph, the gate of Benjamin, and the gate of Dan. ³³On the south side, ... three gates, the gate of Simeon, the gate of Issachar, and the gate of Zebulun. ³⁴On the west side, ... three gates, the gate of Gad, the gate of Asher, and the gate of Naphtali. ³⁵ ... And the name of the city from that time on shall be, The LORD Is There.”

Revelation 21:¹²It had a great, high wall, with twelve gates, and at the gates twelve angels, and on the gates the names of the twelve tribes of the sons of Israel were inscribed— ¹³on the east three gates, on the north three gates, on the south three gates, and on the west three gates. ¹⁴And the wall of the city had twelve foundations, and on them were the twelve names of the twelve apostles of the Lamb.
