PROFILE OF CANDIDATE FOR PASTOR

RAYMOND RAJ a/I PONNUTHURAI

When Raymond was a teenager, he heeded the call of God to serve as a full-time minister. Before being a pastor, he worked in multiple secular fields. Raymond was a canine handler at Stephen's Kennel, an AIA Insurance Agent, and a hotelier. Raymond resigned from KL Equatorial in 1993 to join the Methodist Church in Malaysia as a full-time employee. In the ensuing year, doors opened for him to pursue his Theological Degree at Malaysia Theological Seminary (STM). In 1998, he graduated with a



bachelor's In Theology (B. Th). After years of serving Christ as a Methodist pastor, in 2010, Raymond earned his Master of Ministry (M. Min). Subsequently, he enrolled in the Doctor of Ministry Programme (D. Min).

In 2000, Bishop Dr Peter Chiau ordained Raymond as a reverend in the Tamil Annual Conference (TAC) of the Methodist Church in Malaysia. The Lord developed Raymond into an adept itinerant senior pastor of numerous congregations in TAC. Raymond served the flock by praying for the sick, visiting church families, sharing the gospel with non-believers, providing marital counselling, baptising souls, and training church leaders. Raymond also demonstrated the love of Jesus to people on their deathbeds and comforted dismayed families who grieved the death of their loved ones. In the latter years of serving as a TAC pastor, the Lord used Raymond to mentor student pastors. Today, the students he trained are ordained pastors that serve the Lord by pastoring TAC churches.

In 2008, upon hearing the call of God and standing inspired, Raymond and the deacons of Tamil Methodist Church Sungai Pelek launched Ray of Hope Ministries (ROH). They witnessed the hand of God in the ministry and the compassion of Christ for the least privilege in society. ROH developed a good rapport with the local police, the Sepang Department of Social Welfare (JKMS), and other organisations that wanted to make a difference in society. ROH built orphanages that shelter, and nurture neglected and orphaned girls, boys, pregnant adolescents, and single mothers.

In 2018, Pastor Raymond joined the Assemblies of God (AOG) to serve the Lord as a preacher. As Assistant Pastor, Raymond led and taught the flock through online bible study sessions. The study sessions built up biblical knowledge of Christians from Malaysia and Indonesia. During this time, Raymond showed the love of Christ to church members through home visitations, prayer, and pastoral counselling.

In decades of serving, many have appreciated Raymond for his ability to preach the Word of God and conduct Bible study. His comprehension of Christian Theology and gift to teach others the Word in depth have enlightened hundreds over the years. The Lord also trained Raymond to help people by providing pastoral counselling and mentoring. As someone who constantly sees the love of Jesus, Raymond is a valuable vessel in social concerns ministries.

God has anointed Raymond to build capable church leaders over the years. He prioritises serving the Lord with integrity and wholeheartedness. Raymond believes it is right to live an uncompromised Christian life and share sound Christian doctrine. He pastors congregations with the solemn desire for churches to flourish and the furtherance of the Kingdom of Christ.
