FORGIVEN and FORGOTTEN

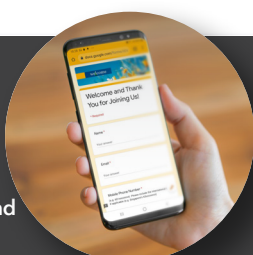

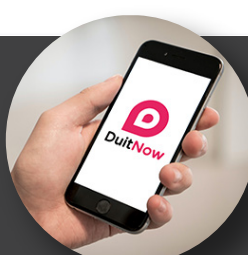

Unfortunately, we don't get a second chance at our past. We cannot undo our callous actions. We cannot reattempt at raising our children. We cannot choose a different first job and rechart our career paths. Initial impressions cannot be remade. Cutting remarks cannot be taken back. Scars cannot be completely removed. Our memories remain with us.

Our past regrets and offenses can continue to haunt us and impede our spiritual growth when we allow them to fester in our minds and when we permit unresolved issues to keep us under the bondage of guilt.

As we run the race of life before us, may we resolve to let go of our past regrets, mistakes and wrong doings, and accept the full forgiveness that our gracious Lord has given us. The Bible promises, "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness". (1 John 1:9)

We have full and complete forgiveness; His grace frees us completely. Our sins are forgiven by our gracious Father who also chooses to overlook ("forget") our offences. He does not keep a record of our wrongs when we repent and seek His forgiveness.

God's Word promises, "I, even I, am He who blots out your transgressions, for My own sake, and remembers your sins no more." (Isaiah 43:25) God also promises us in Jeremiah 31:34 that "(our) sins and lawless acts (He) will remember no more."


The best news for sinners (that's you and I) is that God forgives sin, and when He does, it is erased from the eternal record. Our gracious God chooses not to remember, not to keep score.

There's no sense in allowing the guilt of your past to haunt you long into the future. Make right with the Lord, and ask forgiveness of anyone you feel you've wronged.

We can take confidence and be assured that God will not summon up the thoughts and purposes of our past follies, that He will not treat us as if He remembered our wrongdoings; He will treat us as if they were forgotten. Blotted out, erased, cleansed completely... forgiven by His grace.

We move forward in our discipleship journey making certain we guard our words, carry ourselves in a way that is honouring to the Lord, and usher grace to others.

May we, like Paul, break free from the guilt of the past and press forward relying on the grace of God.

"Brothers and sisters, I do not consider myself yet to have taken hold of it. But one thing I do: Forgetting what is behind and straining toward what is ahead I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus." (Philippians 3:13-14)

Recognizing the need for the women in FBC to come together to support, encourage, and build one another up in our journey of faith, we are trusting God to guide us in leading the Women's Ministry.

- To be ambassadors of love, agents of peace, and channels of blessing.

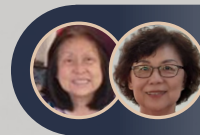
What is the Women's Ministry looking forward to in the coming year?
