Besides providing residential care for PLHIV, Crisis Home also provides public health and education strategies aimed at reducing the transmission of HIV-associated stigma. We believe that prevention is better than cure - as there is no cure for HIV yet, we recognize and advocate that preventing the virus from spreading is the most durable, long-term solution. It is through these outreaches that Crisis Home was set up. Many PLHIV came and learned about how HIV/AIDS is transmitted. They realized that they themselves were transmitting the virus, and saw the need to change their lifestyle and help to prevent the virus from spreading. After staying in Crisis Home for a time, some of them have now gone back to the street where they were from before, sharing with others on how to prevent the virus from spreading.

### Our objectives are:

- To provide care, love, and support for PLHIV in a Christian environment.
- To extend the saving grace of God into their lives.
- To build faith and hope in our Living and personal God.
- To protect the integrity of PLHIV by showing mercy and encouraging faith, hope, love, forgiveness, and grace.
- To train those who are in the recovery process to be involved in social work and help others who are living with HIV/AIDS and their affected families.
- To provide awareness and prevention programs in schools, colleges, and places of worship.
- To participate in HIV/AIDS community awareness efforts to challenge the stigma and prejudice surrounding HIV/AIDS.

### Crisis Home's program structure includes:

Shelter Home Program

Crisis Home provides a safe and non-violent environment for PLHIV. Crisis Homes provides PLHIV food, medical care, rehabilitation, and where needed, a decent funeral arrangement. Crisis Homes have a capacity to serve 36 clients at any one time.

As part of our care, we provide referrals for clinics and medical facilities facility, harm reduction programs, as well as support for other matters pertaining to legal, social, employment, and etc. We facilitate hospital appointments, health, and HIV monitoring, antiretroviral therapy, and basic physiotherapy, as well as attend to personal needs of PLHIV, which may include daily dressing, bathing, and feeding. PLHIVs are also supported with in-house counseling, work therapy, and reconciliation/reunification with their families.

Crisis Home participates in two annual events, namely the International AIDs Memorial Day and World AIDs Day to bring awareness and remove fear, prejudice, and stigma. Crisis home also organizes camps/retreats for PLHIV.

### **Cottage Industries**

Crisis Home actively promotes employment opportunities to improve quality of life and to assist and educate PLHIV on the importance of living independently so as not to be a burden to their family and loved ones.




