Genesis 13:12 Abram settled in the land of Canaan, while Lot settled among the cities of the valley and moved his tent as far as Sodom.








#### Billionaires who own the same wealth as half the world







#### NO RESPECT OF THE RESIDENTS



**Source:** Deaths involving COVID-19 by vaccination status, England: deaths occurring between 2 January and 24 September 2021







# GOD SPARES ZOAR

Genesis 19:21-22 (ESV) He said to him, "Behold, I grant you this favor also, that I will not overthrow the city of which you have spoken. 22 Escape there quickly, for I can do nothing till you arrive there." Therefore the name of the city was called Zoar.

#### WHY WAS LOT SAVED?

Genesis 19:29 So it was that, when God destroyed the cities of the valley, God <u>remembered</u> Abraham and sent Lot out of the midst of the overthrow when he overthrew the cities in which Lot had lived. In answer to Abraham's Prayer Blessing of the covenant
