## What is the character of great faith?

Matthew 15:21-28 records Jesus' uncharacteristic response (Jesus being unlike Jesus) to the Canaanite woman, but this was done to refine and draw out the woman's faith.

Through the woman's faith, we learnt that the character of great faith is (1) recognizing who Jesus really is & (2) who we really are.

In the times of troubles and difficulties, remember that we can approach God even in our brokenness and seek him for restoration which Jesus provided at the Cross.




## Have you ever wanted to accomplish something big before?

We all want to be known for something - whether be it a career or a hobby we'd like to share with others to receive recognition. Similarly, Jesus also wanted to receive recognition from us.

When Jesus was walking on water, all the disciples at first glance were not able to tell that the man was Jesus. And even Peter, who thought he was bold, was hesitant. And as he was crossing the waters, he got distracted by the wind, and sank. Just like Peter, we can focus too much on our personal reasons for doubting God. Peter's personal reason was because of his fisherman's instinct, to retreat when the wind got strong. When we place too much focus on our doubts, we lose balance, just like Peter did.

Is our faith in God based off the crowd, or is it based off our hearts? God invites us to have a personal relationship with Him so that we can see Him for who He is through our own two eyes.



Jesus' resurrection is the only sign we need to know that He has authority over everything.

## What is the character of great faith?

Time and time again the Bible shows that earthly kings have failed, but God does not! We get to see that God has a redemption plan for humanity, to redeem us from sin. And this involves a king because we need a role model.

We may be feeling doubtful and troubled, and that's normal! God knows that too. When we are troubled, God will comfort us. When we are doubtful, God will equip us. And when we faithfully submit to Him, God will bless us.

Therefore, let us find comfort in knowing that the Creator of the universe cares for us, and will equip us in whatever He calls us to do :D







### How often do you remember that God is always by your side?

John the Baptist had the confidence to continue preaching God's word and about repentance in face of opposition by King Herod himself! That's because he trusted in God's sovereignty, that God's word is perfect and not tainted by our sinfulness.

Like John, God is also always with us in face of troubles and opposition. We may not realize it, but He is sovereign over us and our sufferings, and through the Spirit of God He assures us of His love for us. We can stand firm in faith and have courage because of His word, His people, and His spirit. In knowing that the very God who created the universe, who created you and I, loves us, do we have any reason to be afraid?



### "God"- we have different views and opinions on how we view God.

Some may view Him as one who is perfect and, hence, we must chase after perfection. Some may view Him as one who is strict and, hence, we must follow the Laws strictly.

How we approach God is very much based on our views. For example, if we view Him as a perfect God we might only approach Him when we are "perfect".

How about rest? When we see God, can we see rest? God doesn't oppress His people with more stuff to do and guidelines to follow in order to be with Him. He is with us through the blood of Christ.

The art displays children going to God with full happiness and reassurance. We too can approach God with full assurance and happiness because we can delight in the rest which is found in Him.
