concerned.


The impact that being part of a Life Group has had on us continues to bless, change our life for the better, and

Despite traveling very long to reach Nahor (~1450km), it was logical for the servant to stay a few days and enjoy the host's hospitality. Yet, there was a sense of urgency from the servant, already asking to go back in the morning instead of resting more by saying: "do not detain me." This shows his eagerness to go back to Abraham, his master.

### **Application**

- We are servants of Christ, do we feel the same sense of urgency to go back to Him?
- Who do we find our identity in? The ways of this world, or in Christ? Who is your master?

We find other things more urgent or more important than God, and our priorities shift, placing God last.
We keep delaying our time to actually seek Him.

We forget that while striving to provide for ourselves, He is the ultimate Provider. When you face a situation that potentially delays you from pursuing a relationship with God (eg. exams, friends, or just 'too busy'), stop and reflect first, remember His grace and providence.

### **Prayer**

Dear God, I am Your servant. You are my Master. Instill in me a heart of desire and urgency to seek You always, just like Abraham's servant. Amen.
