SPECIAL TEENS Ministry Update


SPECIAL TEENS SPORTS MINISTRY (2015)

Hence, my journey in this ministry began with sharing about the importance of sports through a workshop for more than 30 families at the Globe Café (physical activities galore) for the Teens with special needs and challenging behaviors.

BUDDIES' CHATLINE (2020)

The onset of COVID-19 pandemic has changed and affected our lives in many ways. For our children who have special needs, this has also caused various issues, dilemmas, struggles in the families as the needs for social connection, interaction and physical activities became Imminent. God's way is always above our ways and nothing is impossible with our God.

Buddies' Chat Line was God's handiwork likened to opening a river in the desert (Isaiah 43:19). It quenched the thirst for meeting friends, care and share, and have fun learning together.

Topics like the Fruit of the Spirit, the Beatitudes are some of the themes that were chosen to engage the Teens and Young Adults, intertwined with singing, reading/ memorizing verses together, art and crafts, Brain Gym activities.



PARENTS CONNECT GROUP (2019)

As a body of Christ, the vision and mission of this ministry have always been to share God's love and hope that can only be found in Jesus.

Consequently, the Parents Connect Group was started with the life group format. We started with a short-term study on the book *Purpose Driven Life* which rounded up with sharing the gospel message through John 3:16 passage.

Since then, we have also inserted some special needs Teens support strategies teaching, living skills activities in the meetings.

During the pandemic time, MCO and CMCO, God has provided the opportunity to take the gathering onto online Zoom meeting, and collaborating with FBC Kitchen Ministry/Soup Kitchen, Community Care Ministry in caring for the families who have various needs.

In 2022, with God's providence, we were able to invite some overseas experts from countries such as Singapore, Philippines, and Taiwan to conduct online classes and individual consultation sessions.
