Biblical Principle

James 2:1-7 1 My brothers, show no partiality as you hold the faith in our Lord Jesus Christ, the Lord of glor.

2 For if a man wearing a gold riperate by comes into your assembly, and a poor man in shabby clothing also comes in, 3 and if you pay a stand over the fine clothing and say, "You sit here in a good place," while you say to the poor man, "You stand over there," or, "Sit down at my feet,"

4 have you not then made distinc Reasoning s and become judges with evil thoughts? 5 Listen, my beloved brothers, has not God chosen those who are poor in the world to be rich in faith and heirs of the kingdom, which he has promised to those who love him? 6 But you have dishonored the poor man. Are not the rich the ones who oppress you, and the ones who drag you into court? 7 Are they not the ones who blaspheme the

onorable name by wiffor you were carred:



FIRST MISUNDERSTANDING OF THE LAW

FIRST MISUNDERSTANDING OF THE LAW

The words are <u>not a command</u> to love yourself; they are an assumption: love your neighbor as you *already* love yourself

THE FOCUS IS THE OTHER







Luke 15:32 (ESV) It was fitting to celebrate and be glad, for this your brother was dead, and is alive; he was lost, and is found. "







2. WE CANNOT PICK AND CHOOSE WHICH LAWS TO OBEY


THEY CLOSED THEIR HEARTS TO THE POOR

Social injustice to the poor is just as bad a murder or adultery






LOVING OUR NEIGHBOR MEANS SOCIAL JUSTICE



LETTER FROM BIRMINGHAM

Whenever the early Christians entered a town, the people in power became disturbed and immediately sought to convict the Christians for being "disturbers of the peace" and "outside agitators." But the Christians pressed on, in the conviction that they were "a colony of heaven," called to obey God rather than man. Small in number, they were big in commitment. They were too God-intoxicated to be "astronomically intimidated." By their effort and example they brought an end to such ancient evils as infanticide and gladiatorial contests




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4. OUR CHALLENGE: ACTION MATTERS, WORDS DON'T
