How would you rate your relationship with God?





"Is Following Christ Easy?"

- 1. Following Christ is not easy and involves suffering, sacrifice, and going against worldly values and personal ambitions.
- 2. It requires daily consent to God's changing work and the training of one's spiritual muscles.
- 3. The battle between the flesh and the spirit makes following Christ challenging.
- 4. Denying self and obeying God's commands can be difficult but is necessary.
- 5. Living in an anti-Christian culture and facing rejection when sharing the Gospel adds to the difficulty.
- 6. Following Christ involves relying on God's grace, strength, and guidance.
- 7. Doubts and struggles may arise, but Jesus promises to walk alongside His followers.
- 8. It requires discipline, humility, and constant reliance on the Holy Spirit.
- 9. Following Christ means going against the flow of worldly cultures and






What Abides in us?
