Devotions by the Youth:

(Proclaim the Good News)

Scripture

Acts 21:13: Then Paul answered, "Why are you weeping and breaking my heart? I am ready not only to be bound, but also to die in Jerusalem for the name of the Lord Jesus".

Observation

Paul, from someone who once persecuted and killed Christians, now was willing to be persecuted for being one. It's amazing to see how God can transform stubborn hearts and humble those who are arrogant.

Maybe during this time, Paul had thought of the people he had persecuted and felt guilt and shame for doing so. Maybe that could be the driving force behind Paul's determination to go to Jerusalem granted by God.

Application

Paul's transformation was from one extreme to the other. What can be said about us, those who have always been in the middle? Most of us have been Christians since young and have always stayed in our safety bubble. We avoid or don't bring up the Gospel to others for fear of being ostracized by others.



Yet, to muster up the courage like Paul is not easy. Paul must've felt terrified too, basically walking into a potential death zone. But he lets God take control of wherever he went and whatever he did. We can ask ourselves, "What is stopping us from spreading the Gospel to non-believers?", but more importantly we should ask "Am I doing something to overcome this barrier(s)?"

Prayer

Dear God, only You can change the most hardened and hostile hearts, just like you did for Paul. You can use anyone for Your works. You also know how weak our hearts are, how we prefer to stay in comfort instead of spreading Your Word. It is not easy for us, and You know that too. I pray that when we think of staying in our comforting shell, we will find strength and courage from You to speak out your Word. After all, we are merely vessels to bring others to You. Amen.

Scripture

Acts 21:26: The next day Paul took the men and purified himself along with them. Then he went to the temple to give notice of the date when the days of purification would end and the offering would be made for each of them.

Observation

Paul was accused of things that he did not do. Yet, even when he is not under the law (for he is a slave to Christ and not the law), he still chooses to do what was customary for the Jews in purifying themselves to show their innocence.

Application

Being in Christ does not mean being ignorant of the culture or customs of those with who we are sharing the gospel too. Sometimes the best way to be Christ's ambassadors is to also show our understanding towards those to who we are reaching out too.

What good would it bring if we proclaim the goodness of Christ yet blatantly do things that tick off the unbelievers? For example, I would never invite my devout Hindu-believing friends to a beef noodle shop and proclaim the Gospel, nor would those religiously fasting friends for lunch while proclaiming the Gospel to them.

Both would need to go hand-in-hand, evangelizing and understanding the culture/custom of those who we want to reach.

Prayer

Father in heaven, how creative you are to raise nations up with all kinds of tribes and tongues. But at the same time, what a barrier it is for us to proclaim your word to these tribes and tongues. O Lord, grant me a heart in wanting to understand them; their customs and culture, so that I may break down those barriers when proclaiming the good news to them. Transform me O Lord, would you do that? In Jesus' name, Amen.
