Devotion by the Youth: Psalms 61 & 62 **Sheltering and Resting in God**

Scripture

"I long to dwell in Your tent forever and take refuge in the shelter of Your wings" - Psalm 61:4

Observation

Often times when the psalmist writes down a place where he longs to dwell in God's presence, the word sanctuary, house, or temple is often used. But for 61v4, the psalmist uses the word 'tent'. This is by far the only occurrence where God's dwelling can be found in a place characterized as a tent. But what is so significant about God's dwelling in a tent?

me a house to dwell in? I have not dwelt in a house from the day I brought the Israelites up out of Egypt to this day. I have been moving from place to place with a tent as my dwelling"

Application

God's dwelling place in a tent, reminds us that God is always moving. Wherever he went, Israel followed in obedience. Wherever he stopped, Israel also stopped in obedience.

This is a reminder to me that God's dwelling place is not only a place for me to take refuge and find comfort, but also a direction where the Lord would lead me. Do I long like how the psalmist longs? Do I long to travel alongside God and follow his lead? Or am I bound by my comforts that I cling on to?



Wherever you'll go, I'll go. Give me the strength to not only pronounce that, but to uphold that statement. How fragile am I to cling to temporary comforts? Am I not moved by your grace and mercy that you've shown me day after day? Give me a heart that longs to dwell in your tent, even if it means to get myself out from my comfort zone. Give me strength, In Jesus name, Amen
