JAMES 4:11-12

11 Brothers and sisters, do not slander one another. Anyone who speaks against a brother or sister or judges them speaks against the law and judges it. When you judge the law, you are not keeping it, but sitting in judgment on it. 12 There is only one Lawgiver and Judge, the one who is able to save and destroy. But you—who are you to judge your neighbor?

Slander \neq defame



Do not slander

- Katalaleō = to speak badly about someone
- It may be entirely true
- Highlight needless fault
- We pick our preferred morally superior position

Promoted to manager in 6 months Always late Not friendly Refuse to eat mixed rice Always dinner with the boss Hair is very curly



What is the purpose?

- To make them lose respect
- Drain their social capital
- To directly/indirectly elevate yourself
- To destroy instead of save a relationship




