After wandering in the wilderness for a couple of years, in God's gracious mercies and providence, we were able to "start" coming back physically in 2022 especially for our younger members in the second half of the year. There was still much anxiety and reservations. For good reason too.

What and whose SOPs needed to be followed and contingencies that had to put in place to mitigate the risks should that become necessary.

We are thankful for that period of "experimentation" in 2022 as it equipped us with the necessary experience for full physical return this year, 2023.

Thus it is with much thankfulness we kicked off 2023 with our first fully physical parade for the entire company on Saturday 16th of February – 3 years since things got derailed by COVID-19.

Murphy's law decided to spice things up when electricity supply was interrupted briefly, forcing us to start off in the Garden Cafe.

Thankfully it didn't last long and we could resume in the hall in comfort once the supply was restored. The break enforced by the pandemic also enabled us to revisit how we ran things and with a limited team of officers that is not getting any younger, we decided to raise the starting age for members from 6 years old to 8 years old.

Another significant change made was separating the Junior section into 2 groups; lower Juniors aged 8 to 10 years and upper Juniors aged 11 and 12 years.











There is more that can be said for the year but it would perhaps only create a wrong impression of BB as only about outdoor and fun activities. In reality those are just occasional highlights. The weekly reality is perhaps a little more mundane and less exciting.
