Study 8 The Gospel in Life

1. Which of the two errors moralism and irreligiosity poses the most danger to you? Keller states that if you think one of these errors [legalism or license] is much more dangerous than the other, you are probably partially participating in the one you fear less." Which error have you tended to fear less, and why? What does this tell you of the nature of these dangers

2. Discuss how the moralism or irreligiosity affects this area in your life and how you gradually apply the gospel truth to enable your own transformation
 - a. Discouragement and Depression
 - b. Love and relationships
 - c. Dealing with people in church
 - d. Dealing with migrant workers
 - e. Dealing with colleagues or competitors in the office
 - f. Our motivation to evangelise
 - g. Guilt and self image

3. The Gospel brings in the reality of our new identity, motivations and thinking which guides our life and ministry. There are three specific dimension of gospel thinking that impacts how we live and minister. These aspects are
 1. Incarnation/upside-down
 2. Atone- ment/inside-out
 3. Resurrection/forward-back.

These concepts intuitively defies our usual logical thought and natural actions and traditions. What do we feel about this and how are we going to tackle this and make it real in our lives? Discuss how these aspects impact how we think and minister in church
