






#### CURTAILING OUR RIGHTS FOR LOVE



# Paul has legitimately rights

1 Corinthians 9:4-6 (ESV)

Do we not have the right to eat and drink?

5 Do we not have the right to take along a believing wife, as do the other apostles and the brothers of the Lord and Cephas? 1 Corinthians 6 Or is it only Barnabas and I who have no right to refrain from working for a living?

# 3 METAPHORS

Or who tends a flock without getting some of the milk?

Who serves as a soldier at his own expense?

Who plants a vineyard without eating any of its fruit?

Proof of legitimately rights

Common wisdom



1 Corinthians 9:8-10 (ESV) Do I say these things on human authority? Does not the Law say the same? 9 For it is written in the Law of Moses, "You shall not muzzle an ox when it treads out the grain." (Deut 25:4) Is it for oxen that God is concerned? 10 Does he not certainly speak for our sake?

1 Timothy 5:18 (ESV) For the Scripture says, "You shall not muzzle an ox when it treads out the grain," and, "The laborer deserves his wages."

# EVERYONE WHO CONTRIBUTES HAS A LEGITIMATE RIGHT TO A SHARE

1 Corinthians 9:10-12 (ESV) It was written for our sake, because the plowman should plow in hope and the thresher thresh in hope of sharing in the crop. 11 If we have sown spiritual things among you, is it too much if we reap material things from you? 12 If others share this rightful claim on you, do not we even more?

# PAUL HAS INSTEAD SACRIFICED HIS RIGHTS

It is not because he is weak of is undeserving but instead because he is strong and has sacrificed his rights for the love of others

l Corinthians 9:12 (ESV) If others share this rightful claim on you, do not we even more?

Nevertheless, we <u>have not made use of this right</u>, but we endure anything rather than put an obstacle in the way of the gospel of Christ.

### THE CONCLUSION

1 Corinthians 9:13-14 (ESV) Do you not know that those who are employed in the temple service get their food from the temple, and those who serve at the altar share in the sacrificial offerings?

14 In the same way, the Lord commanded that those who proclaim the gospel should get their living by the gospel.

1 Corinthians 9:15 (ESV) But I have made no use of any of these rights, nor am I writing these things to secure any such provision. For I would rather die than have anyone deprive me of my ground for boasting.

## GOSPEL FREEDOM PARADOX

I Corinthians 9:19 (ESV) For though I am free from all, I have made myself a servant to all, that I might win more of them.

1 Corinthians 9:20-21 (ESV) To the Jews I became as a Jew, in order to win Jews. To those under the law I became as one under the law (though not being myself under the law) that I might win those under the law. 21 To those outside the law I became as one outside the law (not being outside the law of God but under the law of Christ) that I might win those outside the law.







# IF SURESH WAS A CHRISTIAN WHAT SHOULD HE HAVE DONE


Relinquish his rights in love and close shop?
