



SONG OF MOSES





(Gk-EnLex_NT) to express oneself in low tones of disapprobation, grumble, murmur

Discontent

Against a person..loss of faith



Voice of unbelief Unwilling to believe that God is allowing this disappointment to grow our faith

Preaching boring

Food tasteless

Messy

Unfriendly

Grumbling about person or circumstance is same as grumbling against God

COMPLAINING

Numbers 14:2-4 (ESV) And all the people of Israel grumbled against Moses and Aaron. The whole congregation said to them, "Would that we had died in the land of Egypt! Or would that we had died in this wilderness! 3 Why is the Lord bringing us into this land, to fall by the sword? Our wives and our little ones will become a prey. Would it not be better for us to go back to Egypt?" 4 And they said to one another, "Let us choose a leader and go back to Egypt."


TWO KINDS OF TEMPTATIONS




OVERCONFIDENT-"SUPER SPIRITUAL"



THE SAME DANGER OF IDOLATRY ISRAEL FACED



1 Corinthians 10:18 (ESV) Consider the people of Israel: are not those who eat the sacrifices participants in the altar?

1 Corinthians 10:19-22 (ESV) What do I imply then? That food offered to idols is anything, or that an idol is anything? 20 No, I imply that what pagans sacrifice they offer to demons and not to God. I do not want you to be participants with demons. 21 You cannot drink the cup of the Lord and the cup of demons. You cannot partake of the table of the Lord and the table of demons. 22 Shall we provoke the Lord to jealousy? Are we stronger than he?

PRINCIPLES OF LIVING

THE GOSPEL AND FREEDOM

1 Corinthians 10:25-30 (ESV) Eat whatever is sold in the meat market without raising any question on the ground of conscience. 26 For "the earth is the Lord's, and the fullness thereof." 27 If one of the unbelievers invites you to dinner and you are disposed to go,

eat whatever is set before you without raising any question on the ground of conscience

28 But if someone says to you, "This has **been offered** in sacrifice" then do not eat it, for the sake of the one who informed you and for the sake of conscience—29 I do not mean your conscience, but his. For why should my liberty be determined by someone else's conscience? 30 If I partake with thankfulness, why am I denounced because of that for which I give thanks?

THE GOSPEL AND FREEDOM

1 Corinthians 10:31-33 (ESV) So, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God. 32 Give no offense to Jews or to Greeks or to the church of God, 33 just as I try to please everyone in everything I do, not seeking my own advantage, but that of many, that they may be saved.


