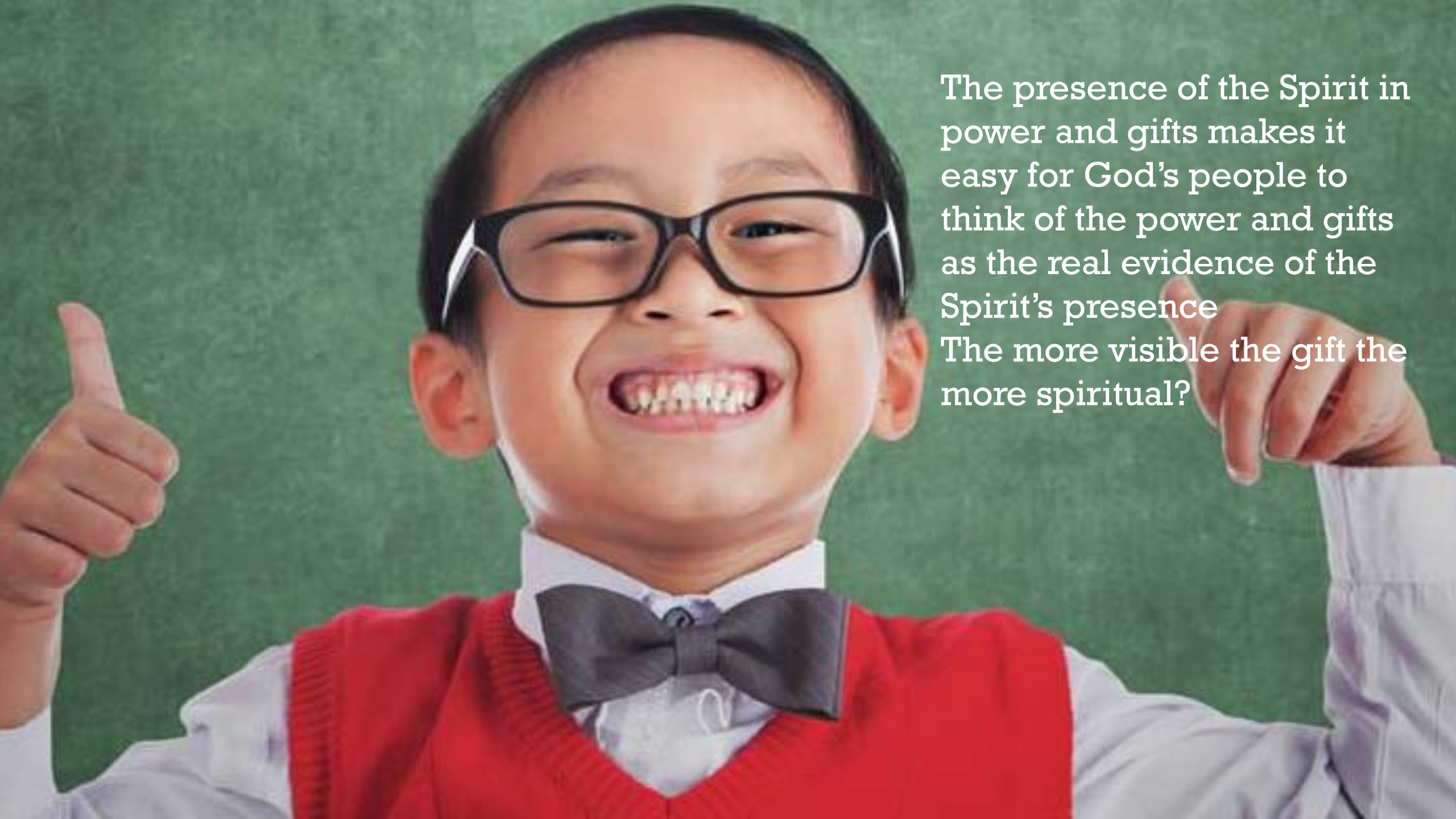

I Corinthians 12a

Spiritual things or spiritual manifestations

Pneumatikon

1 Corinthians 12:1-3 (ESV) Now concerning spiritual gifts, brothers, I do not want you to be uninformed. 2 You know that when you were pagans you were led astray to mute idols, however you were led. 3 Therefore I want you to understand that no one speaking in the Spirit of God ever says "Jesus is accursed" and no one can say "Jesus is Lord" except in the Holy Spirit.



The presence of the Spirit in power and gifts makes it easy for God's people to think of the power and gifts as the real evidence of the Spirit's presence

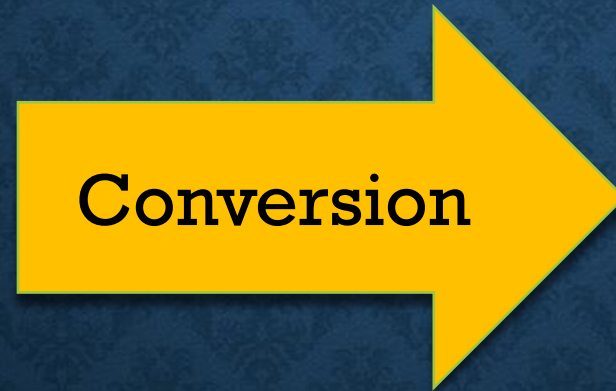

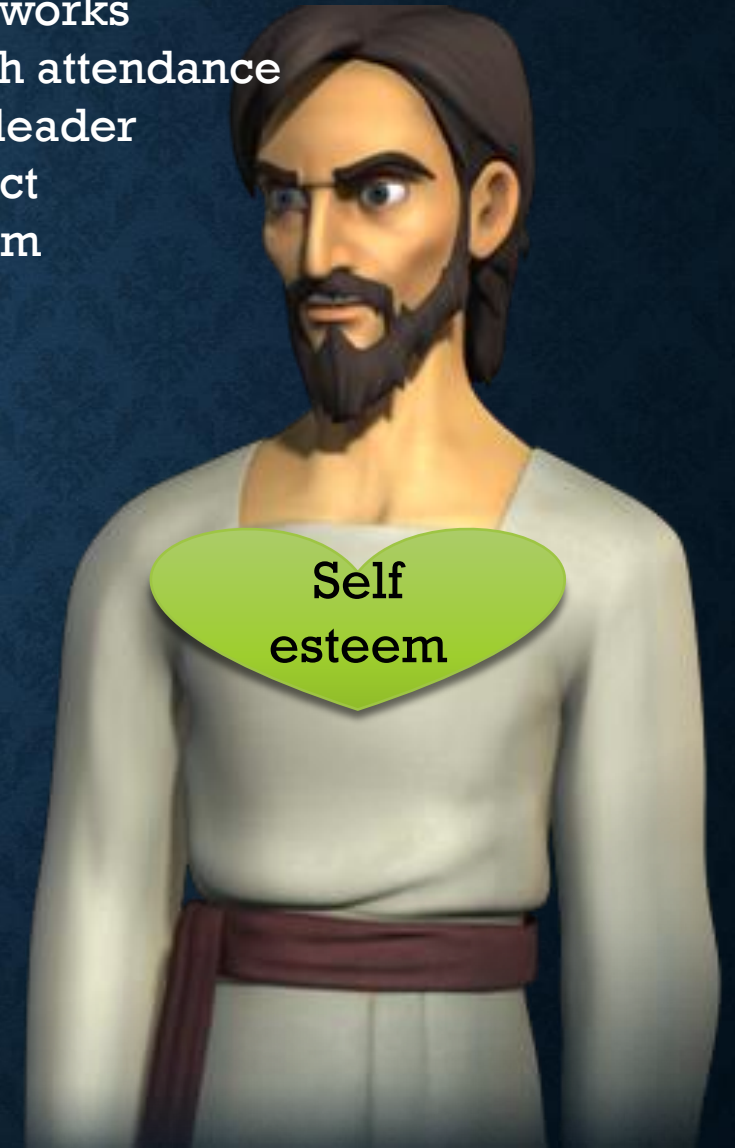

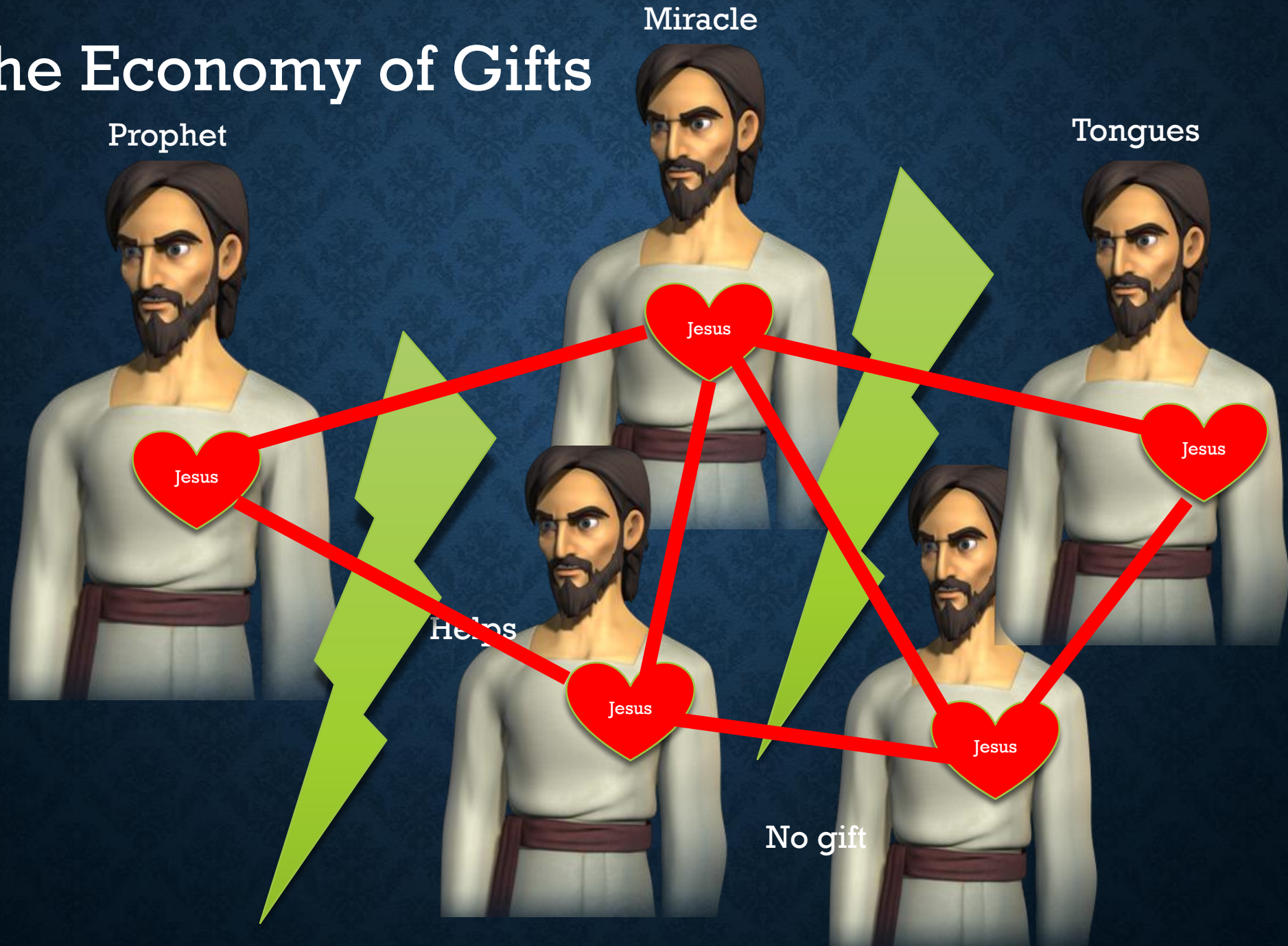

1 Corinthians 12:7-11 (ESV) To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good. 8 For to one is given through the Spirit the utterance of wisdom, and to another the utterance of knowledge according to the same Spirit. 9 to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healing by the one Spirit, 10 to another the working of miracles, to another prophecy, to another the ability to distinguish between spirits, to another various kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues. 11 All these are empowered by one and the same Spirit, who apportions to each one individually as he wills.

BASIS OF UNITY

DIVISIVE PROBLEMS

- 1 Baptism of HS separate second experience necessary for all Christians**
- 2 Speaking in tongues the external evidence of baptism and infilling of the Spirit**
- 3 Gifts like tongues and miracles must be present in every church ...like apostles**

ACTS 2 NARRATIVE

**NARRATIVES ALONE ARE INSUFFICIENT
FOR DEFINITIVE DOCTRINE**

filled the entire house where they were sitting. 3 And divided tongues as of fire appeared to them and rested on each one of them. 4 And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit gave them utterance.

LACK OF CORROBORATION ELSEWHERE IN SCRIPTURE

- Spirit baptism not in the character qualifications of deacons and elders if it was so important for Christian ministry (1 Tim. 3; Titus 1)?
- Epistles are universally silent on the subject of Spirit baptism, and it affirms that all believers have the Holy Spirit (1 Cor. 12:13; Gal. 3:27; Rom. 8:9).
- We cannot find a basis for Spirit baptism in the book of Acts—especially when these passages are not uniform and consistent.

1 Corinthians 12:12-13 (ESV) For just as the body is one and has many members, and all the members of the body, though many, are one body, so it is with Christ. 13 For in one Spirit we were all baptized into one body—Jews or Greeks, slaves or free—and all were made to drink of one Spirit

Acts 1:5 (ESV) for John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now.”

THERE ARE NO TWO BAPTISMS

Ephesians 4:4-7 (ESV) There is one body and one Spirit—just as you were called to the one hope that belongs to your call— 5 one Lord, one faith, one baptism, 6 one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all. 7

BODY METAPHOR

1 Corinthians 12:23-24 (ESV) and on those parts of the body that we think less honorable we bestow the greater honor, and our unpresentable parts are treated with greater modesty, 24 which our more presentable parts do not require. But God has so composed the body, giving greater honor to the part that lacked it,

Greater care for less honorable part



BODY METAPHOR

1 Corinthians 12:25-26 (ESV) that there may be no division in the body, but that the members may have the same care for one another. 26 If one member suffers, all suffer together; if one member is honored, all rejoice together.

Total unity and care



1 Corinthians 12:27-31 (ESV) Now you are the body of
God sovereignly gives the gifts
Christ and individually members of it. 28 And God has
appointed in the church first apostles, second
prophets, third teachers, then miracles, then gifts of

“There is no NT principle which states that the believer cannot be in full freedom of the Holy Spirit unless he has spoken in tongues. Experience shows that people do come to know the release of the Spirit in their lives and yet do not speak in tongues and to suggest to them that their experience is not real for that reason is biblically unjustified, possibly harmful and can create unnecessary doubt and bondages”.

Spiritual gifts –miraculous during early church – for accreditation



D. B. WARFIELD OF PRINCETON UNIVERSITY

- Miracles are associated with periods of special revelation to process of writing scripture eg Exodus, Exile, Elijah time
- They attest to and accredit God's message to become Scripture
- Once Scripture formed no need for miraculous gifts

PAUL'S ATTITUDE-CONTINUING NEED FOR GIFTS

- 1 Corinthians 12:7 (ESV) To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good.
- 1 Corinthians 12:31 (ESV) But earnestly desire the higher gifts. And I will show you a still more excellent way.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:20-21 (ESV) Do not despise prophecies, 21 but test everything; hold fast what is good.
- 1 Corinthians 14:1-2 (ESV) Pursue love, and earnestly desire the spiritual gifts, especially that you may prophesy.

Ephesians 2:19-20 (ESV) So then you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God, 20 built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets,

WHAT ABOUT THE REST OF THE HOUSE?



Miracles seen in other times to build up church and not exclusively by apostles so are not necessarily just to attest to the authenticity of apostles only, others also have miracles.

Thousands of extra-biblical revelations that happened *in the first century* not enscripturated and for edification of church yet actively discerned

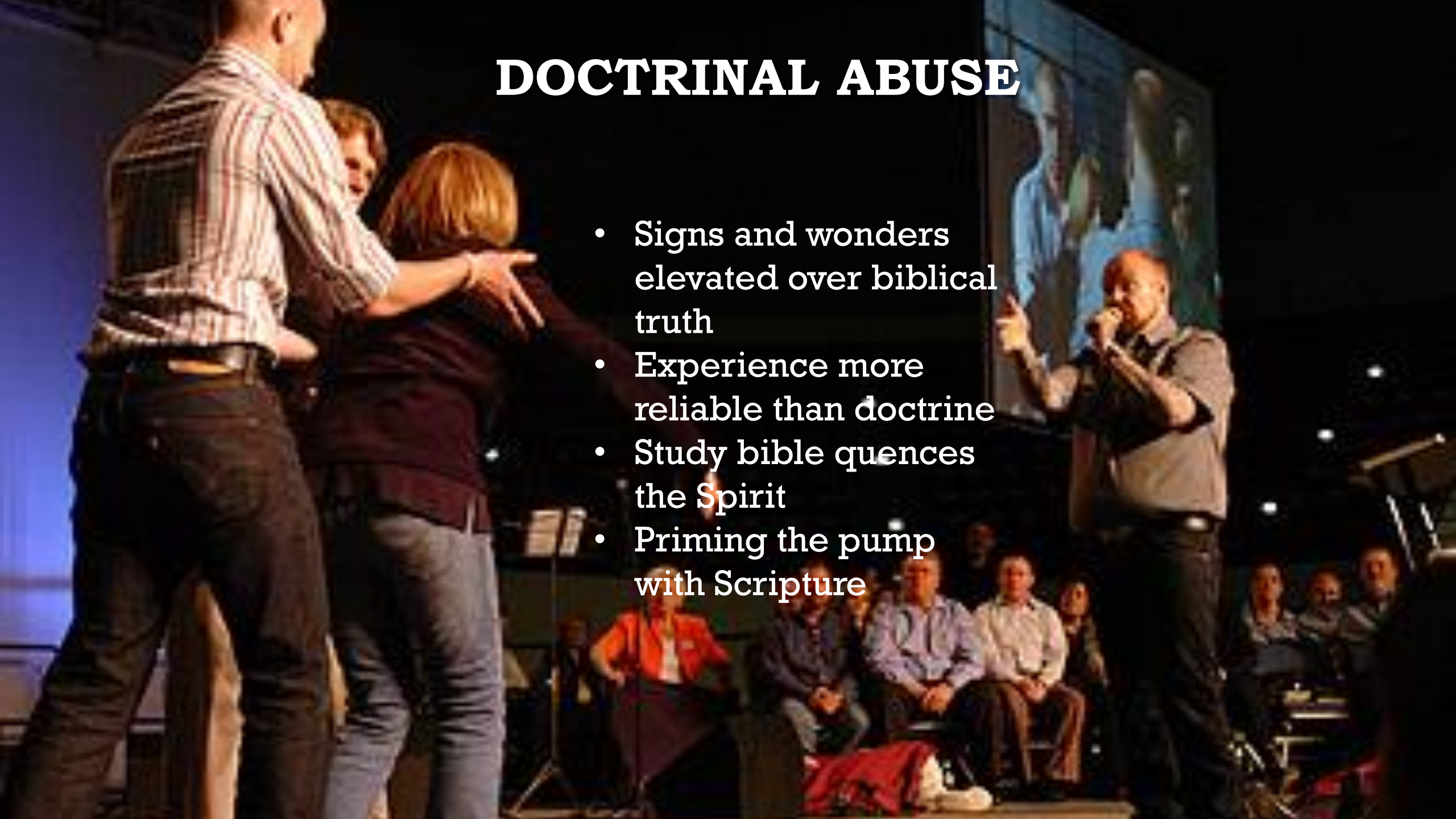
- Extensive NT evidence in Acts and Epistles of the gifts
- Acts 2:17-18 (ESV) And in the last days it shall be, God declares, that I will pour out my Spirit on all flesh, and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams; 18 even on my male servants and female servants in those days I will pour out my Spirit, and they shall prophesy.

Ephesians 4:11-13 (ESV) And he gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the shepherds and teachers, 12 to equip the saints for the work of ministry, for **building up the body of Christ**, 13 until we all attain to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to mature manhood, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ,

- The miracles of Acts are highlights of over 30 yrs of ministry
- Israel wallowed in slavery for 400 years before miracles of Exodus
- John the Baptist demonstrate no miracles
- Esther had no miracles
- Writings of the 2nd and 3rd century showed very little miraculous activity and confined to largely gifts of prophecy and healing, which included exorcism.”
