
8 I say this not as a command, but to **prove** by the earnestness of others that **your love also is genuine**.

15 verbs in 3 verses




THE CORINTHIAN CHURCH IS

Act of holding back one's anger.











Romans 2:4 (ESV) Or do you presume on the riches of his kindness and forbearance and patience, not knowing that God's kindness is meant to lead you to repentance







It seeks the good of many not just the comfort of self does not just seek its own advantage



(ESV) It does not rejoice at wrong doing, but rejoices with the truth.






Love takes no pleasure in someone else's failure, Love delights in integrity and reality. If the situation is bad, love wants to help; If the situation is good, love wants to celebrate.

The obsolescence of current spiritual gifts which are designed for current age

Complete Canon of Scripture

The Corinthians would not have understood what Paul was talking about..the concept of the canon

The church after the completion of the canon 300 years later would have more knowledge than Paul

The church today is not more matured than the one in Paul's time

ILLUSTRATION

I Corinthians 13:11-12 (ESV) When I was a child, I spoke like a child, I thought like a child, I reasoned like a child.
