

- Devoted to serving the Lord








2. Limited time

1 Corinthians 7:29-31 (ESV) This is what I mean, brothers: the appointed time has grown very short. From now on, let those who have wives live as though they had none, 30 and those who mourn as though they were not mourning, and those who rejoice as though they were not rejoicing, and those who buy as though they had no goods, 31 and those who deal with the world as though they had no dealings with it. For the present form of this world is passing away.

3. Single minded focus on the kingdom

1 Corinthians 7:32-34 (ESV) I want you to be free from anxieties. The unmarried man is anxious about the things of the Lord, how to please the Lord. 33 But the married man is anxious Shout world by things how to place his wife. 34 and Not that Single man more holy and married not holy his inter Pressure on time edwoman is anxious about the things of the Lord, how to be holy in body and spirit. But the married woman is anxious

about worldly things, how to please her husband.

4. Personal fulfilment

1 Corinthians 7:38-40 (ESV) 38 So then he who marries his betrothed does well, and he who refrains from marriage will co even better.

39 A wife is bound to her husband as long as he lives. But if her husband dies, she is free to be married to whom she wishes, only in the Lord. 40 Yet in my judgment she is happier if she remains as she is. And I think that I too have the Spirit of God.
