SCRIPTURE

Chapter 12:15: "You're out of your mind," they told her. When she kept insisting that it was so, they said, "It must be his angel."

OBSERVATION

Peter was arrested and kept in prison to be a spectacle to the Jews (via execution) after the Feast of Unleavened Bread is finished. But God had other plans, He sent an angel to rescue Peter from prison and brought him back to the church. During this time, the church has been praying for Peter, but when news of Peter being at their doorstep was announced, the church quickly dismissed it.

APPLICATION

Before I point a finger at the church, I need to consider this: Peter wasn't the first to be arrested and sentenced to death. He's the second (James, the first). I could imagine when James was arrested the church gathered; and prayed for James to be rescued by God but in the end, God handed James over to Herod. In the same way, when Peter was arrested, the church went through the same steps but with a burden in their heart. This was why they were quick to dismiss the claim that Peter was at their doorstep.
