GOSPEL IS BASED ON HISTORY




Therefore death [thanatos], the most fearsome of evils, is nothing to us, seeing as when we exist, death is not present; and when death is present, we do not exist.



ST AUGUSTINE

You ascended from before our eyes and and we turned back grieving only to find you in our hearts

RELATIONAL INTIMACY

John 20:16-18 ESV Jesus said to her, "Mary." She turned and said to him in Aramaic, "Rabboni!" (which means Teacher). 17 Jesus said to her, <u>"Do not cling to me</u>, for I have not yet ascended to the Father; but go to my brothers and say to them,

'I am ascending to my Father and your Father, to my God and your God. '"

Do not cling to me ..she was afraid she would loose him again.. If Jesus ascends means she will never ever loose Him again..thru Spirit So He can come into your heart Romans 8:34 ESV Who is to condemn? Christ Jesus is the one who died—more than that, who was raised who is at the right hand of God, who indeed is <u>interceding for us</u>.

 Hebrews 7:25 ESV Consequently, he is able to save to the uttermost those who draw near to God through him, since he always lives to <u>make intercession for</u> <u>them</u>
