Acts 11:17-18 (ESV) If then God gave the same gift to them as he gave to us when we believed in the Lord Jesus Christ, who was I that I could stand in God's way?" 18 When they heard these things they fell silent. And they glorified God, saying, "Then to the <u>Gentiles</u> <u>also God has granted repentance that leads to life</u>."

Acts 11:23 When he came and saw the grace of God, he was glad, and he exhorted them all to remain faithful to the Lord with steadfast purpose, 24 for he was a good man, full of the Holy Spirit and of faith. And a great many people were added to the Lord

BARNABAS

• Barnabas –Son of Comfort

• Exhorted or encouraged...Parakaleo

Para – to come alongside to be sympathetic or to be near you

Kaleo- To Call or point people towards a goal

Gentle word

Forceful word

English word encouragement --- to soft

English word exhort----too hard

Mixture of truth and love

VERY FEW PEOPLE HAVE BOTH

ORGANIZED SOCIAL ACTION-DISASTER RELIEF

Acts 11:27-30 (ESV) Now in these days prophets came down from Jerusalem to Antioch. 28 And one of them named Agabus stood up and foretold by the Spirit that there would be a great famine over all the world (this took place in the days of Claudius). 29 So the disciples determined, every one according to his ability, to send relief to the brothers living in Judea. 30 And they did so, sending it to the elders by the hand of Barnabas and Saul.

THE KINGDOM STRIKES BACK

Acts 12:22-23 (ESV) And the people were shouting, "The voice of a god, and not of a man!" 23 Immediately an angel of the Lord struck him down, because he did not give God the glory, and he was eaten by worms and breathed his last.




Does it appeal to you

• (Acts 9:1-2 ESV)


CHRISTIANITY SUPPLANTED ALL GREEK AND ROMAN CULTURE

What good is there to say future is personal if you are not here to enjoy it?

FUTURE IS CERTAIN

 Acts 13:27-28 For those who live in Jerusalem and th If he did not die for his own sins when nor u who did he die for? are read every Sabbath, fulfilled them by condemning him. 28 And though they found in him **no guilt** worthy of death, they asked Pilate to have him executed

He did not die for his own sin Resurrection vindicated him then who did he die for

Acts 13:38-39 Let it be known to you therefore, brothers, that through this man <u>forgiveness of sins is</u> <u>proclaimed to you</u>, 39 and by him everyone who believes is freed from everything from which you could not be freed by the law of Moses



"It is finished," (John 19:30 ESV)

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IMMEDIATE RESPONSE

Acts 13:42-43 (ESV) As they went out, the people begged that these things might be told them the next Sabbath. 43 And after the meeting of the synagogue broke up, many Jews and devout converts to Judaism followed Paul and Barnabas, who, as they spoke with them, urged them to continue in the grace of God.

LATER RESPONSE

Acts 13:44-47 (ESV) The next Sabbath almost the whole city gathered to hear the word of the Lord. 45 But when the Jews saw the crowds, they were filled with jealousy and began to contradict what was spoken by Paul, reviling him. 46 And Paul and Barnabas spoke out boldly, saying, "It was necessary that the word of God be spoken first to you. Since you thrust it aside and judge yourselves unworthy of eternal life, behold, we are turning to the Gentiles. 47 For so the Lord has commanded us, saying,

"'I have made you a light for the Gentiles,

that you may bring salvation to the ends of the earth.""

SUCCESS BELONGS TO THE LORD

Acts 13:48-52 (ESV) And when the Gentiles heard this, they began rejoicing and glorifying the word of the Lord, and as many as were appointed to eternal life believed. 49 And the word of the Lord was spreading throughout the whole region. 50 But the Jews incited the devout women of high standing and the leading men of the city, stirred up persecution against Paul and Barnabas, and drove them out of their district. 51 But they shook off the dust from their feet against them and went to Iconium. 52 And the disciples were filled with joy and with the Holy Spirit.
