EFFECT OF THE SPIRIT: ZEAL AND BOLDNESS FOR THE GOSPEL

• Acts 4:31 (ESV) And when they had prayed, the place in which they were gathered together was shaken, and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and continued to speak the word of God with boldness.

ACTS 4:33 EFFECT OF THE SPIRIT: GENEROSITY AND COMPASSION

Work of the Spirit -boldness not dependant on money

Acts 4:32-37 ESV Now the full number of those who believed were of one heart and soul, and no one said that any of the things that belonged to him was his own, but they had everything in common. 33 And with great power the apostles were giving their testimony to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus, and great grace was upon them all. 34 There was not a needy person among them, for as many as were owners of lands or houses sold them and brought the proceeds of what was sold 35 and laid it at the apostles 'feet, and it was distributed to each as any had need. 36 Thus Joseph, who was also called by the apostles Barnabas (which means son of encouragement), a Levite, a native of Cyprus, 37 sold a field that belonged to him and brought the money and laid it at the apostles' feet

RADICAL GENEROSITY OF SPIRIT FILLED EARLY CHURCH

Now the full number of those who believed were of one heart and soul, and no one said that any of the things that belonged to him was his own, but they had everything in common


(Acts 4:32 ESV)



PRINCIPLE

Fairness is not equal to egalitarian communism

2 Corinthians 8:13-14 For I do not mean that others should be eased and you burdened, but that as a <u>matter of fairness</u> 14 your abundance at the present time should supply their need, so that their abundance may supply your need, that there may be fairness

OT BACKGROUND

- Deuteronomy 15:4-5 But there will be no poor among you; for the Lord will bless you in the land that the Lord your God is giving you for an inheritance to possess— 5 if only you will strictly obey the voice of the Lord your God, being careful to do all this commandment that I command you today
- Deuteronomy 15:7 "If among you, one of your brothers should become poor, in any of your towns within your land that the Lord your God is giving you, you shall not harden your heart or shut your hand against your poor brother, 8 but you shall open your hand to him and lend him sufficient for his need, whatever it may be

THE AIM OF THE CHURCH IS NOT TOTAL ERADICATION OF POVERTY BUT GENEROSITY

Deuteronomy 15:11 For there will never cease to be poor in the land. Therefore I command you, 'You shall open wide your hand to your brother, to the needy and to the poor, in your land

OT MOTIVATING FORCE


As the Lord your God has blessed you, you shall give to him. 15 You shall remember that you were a slave in the land of Egypt, and the Lord your God redeemed you; therefore I command you this today (Deuteronomy 15:14-15 ESV)

MOTIVATING FORCE -GOSPEL

2 Corinthians 8:8-9 (ESV) I say this not as a command, but to prove by the earnestness of others that your love also is genuine. 9 For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though he was rich, yet for your sake he became poor, so that you by his poverty might become rich.














JOHN PIPER






FEAR IS PART OF WORSHIP

JOHN PIPER ON OUR PROBLEM


