

### HENRY CHADWICK CAMBRIDGE PROFESSOR OF HISTORY

The expansion of the church seemed an extraordinary chain of improbabilities. Nothing could have been less likely to succeed by any ordinary standard of expectation.







#### RECOGNITION OF STRATEGIC PRIORITIES

.Acts 6:2 And the twelve summoned the full number of the disciples and said, "It is not right that we should give up *preaching the word of God* to serve tables. 3 Therefore, brothers, pick out from among you seven men of good repute, full of the Spirit and of wisdom, whom we will appoint to this duty.

#### THE PROTO-DEACONS WERE GREEK SPEAKING!!!

Acts 6:5 And what they said pleased the whole gathering, and they chose Stephen, a man full of faith and of the Holy Spirit, and Philip, and Prochorus, and Nicanor, and Timon, and Parmenas, and Nicolaus, a proselyte of Antioch. 6
These they set before the apostles, and they prayed and laid their hands on them

#### MINISTRY IS FOR EVERYONE

Ephesians 4:11-12 And he gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the shepherds and teachers, 12 to equip the saints for the work of ministry, for building up the body of Christ

We serve because He came to serve us

#### RESULTS OF THE MANAGEMENT CHANGE

Acts 6:7 And the word of God continued to increase, and the number of the disciples multiplied greatly in Jerusalem, and a great many of the priests became obedient to the faith

Priests usually look after the poor –They can see the difference



#### TROUBLE

Then some of those who belonged to the synagogue of the Freedmen (as it was called), and of the Cyrenians, and of the Alexandrians, and of those from Cilicia and Asia, rose up and disputed with Stephen. 10 But they could not withstand the wisdom and the Spirit with which he was speaking

(Acts 6:9-10 ESV)

Trouble with the teaching not the miracles

Greek speaking Jews from Dispersion wanted to get into good books with Sanhedrin..more Jew than Jews

#### THE INDICTMENT

Acts 6:13-14 "This man never ceases to speak words against this holy place and the law, 14 for we have heard him say that this Jesus of Nazareth will destroy this place and will change the customs that Moses delivered to us.

#### STEVEN'S DEFENCE




#### PATRIARCHS-ABRAHAM ENCOUNTERS GOD NOT TEMPLE BASED

  them and afflict them four hundred years




#### PATRIARCHS-JOSEPH ENCOUNTER WITH GOD IN EGYPT

#### PATRIARCHS-MOSES


Acts 7:36 (ESV) This man led them out, performing wonders and signs in **Egypt** and at the **Red Sea** and in the **wilderness** for forty years

47 But it was Solomon who built a house for him (Acts 7:47 ESV)



#### GOD DOES NOT LIVE IN TEMPLES

Acts 7:48 Yet the Most High does not dwell in houses made by hands, as the prophet says,

49 "Heaven is my throne, and the earth is my footstool. What kind of house will you build for me, says the Lord, or what is the place of my rest? 50 Did not my hand make all these things

#### OT REFERENCE: ISAIAH

Isaiah 66:1-2 Thus says the Lord:

"Heaven is my throne, and the earth is my footstool;

what is the house that you would build for me, and what is the place of my rest?

2 All these things my hand has made, and so all these things came to be, declares the Lord

#### The Charge

Joseph rejected

39 Our fathers refused to obey him, but thrust him aside, and in their hearts they turned to Egypt (Acts 7:37-41 ESV)


#### COUNTER INDICTMENT

Acts 7:51-53"You stiff- necked people, uncircumcised in heart and ears, you always resist the Holy Spirit. As your fathers did, so do you. 52 Which of the prophets did your fathers not persecute? And they killed those who announced beforehand the coming of the Righteous One, whom you have now betrayed and murdered, 53 you who received the law as delivered by angels and did not keep it



#### WAS STEPHEN CONFUSED?

Behold, I see the heavens opened, and the Son of Man standing at the right hand of God

Heb 1:3b After making purification for sins, <u>he</u> sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high,

Most biblical accounts are Jesus seated as His work is fully done

#### HIS LOVE FOR THEM MUST HAVE IMPACTED PAUL

Acts 7:59-60 And as they were stoning Stephen, he called out, "Lord Jesus, receive my spirit." 60 And falling to his knees he cried out with a loud voice, "Lord, do not hold this sin against them." And when he had said this, he fell asleep
