5. Jesus compared himself to the serpent in the desert.(Numbers 21:4-9) What did the bronze serpent deliver the people from? **And what does Jesus deliver us from?**

C. FOR GOD SO LOVED THE WORLD

6. What is your personal understanding of what it means to be saved?(Hint: what are we saved from?)
7. What did it take for you to see His love, receive His grace?
8. How do you feel about the verse that Jesus came into this world to save us and not condemn (punish) us?
9. How do you feel for the people who reject Christ's offer of grace will be 'lost' and thus condemned? Is this fair?

D. CHRIST MUST BECOME MORE IN US

10. What do you think of John's statement, "I must become less and He will become greater?" What does this mean? **How is this a reflection of your spiritual life?** How can it be more so?
