


GOSPEL IS INTELLECTUALISM

The gospel is Dynamic emotional and spiritual experience...gifts, tongues proxy for spirituality


Divorced from death and resurrection of Jesus

Divorced from death and resurrection of Jesus






The gospel is news that creates a life of love, but the life of love is not itself the gospel.

THE AIM OF THE GOSPEL

The greatest good of the gospel is not forgiveness, justification, or eternal life — as good as these are. The highest, fullest, deepest, sweetest good of the gospel is God himself, enjoyed by his redeemed people. The gospel is the good news that God bought for us the everlasting enjoyment of God.

GOSPEL IN ALL OF LIFE



Colossians 1:3-7 (ESV) We always thank God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, when we pray for you, 4 since we heard of your faith in Christ Jesus and of the love that you have for all the saints, 5 because of the hope laid up for you in heaven. Of this you have heard before in the word of the truth, the gospel, 6 which has come to you, as indeed in the whole world it is bearing fruit and increasing—as it also does among you, since the day you heard it and understood the grace of God in truth,

John 15:8 (ESV) By this my Father is glorified, that **you bear** much fruit and so prove to be my disciples.




HOW THE GOSPEL PRODUCES FRUIT

DISTORTION OF THE GOSPEL

Galatians 3:1-6 (ESV) O foolish Galatians! Who has bewitched you? It was before your eyes that Jesus Christ was publicly portrayed as crucified. 2 Let me ask you only this: Did you receive the Spirit by works of the law or by hearing with faith? 3 Are you so foolish? Having begun by the Spirit, are you now being perfected by the flesh? 4 Did you suffer so many things in vain—if indeed it was in vain? 5 Does he who supplies the Spirit to you and works miracles among you do so by works of the law, or by hearing with faith— 6 just as Abraham "believed God, and it was counted to him as righteousness"?

We are not saved because we change but salvation always changes us


Romans 1:16-17 (ESV) For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek. 17 For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith for faith, as it is written, "The righteous shall live by faith."

LEGALISM MORALISM RELIGION

Conservative

High self esteem..judge others

MOTIVES FOR DISTORTION



1. Avoid Jesus as Lord to keep control of their lives..

religious pride and worldly pride

2. Distorted view of God

Irreligious loose sight of the law and holiness of God

The religious person loose sight of love and grace of God

MOTIVES FOR DISTORTION




3. They both deny our sin—and therefore lose the joy and power of grace.

Irreligious deny depth of their sin..message of God's love no impact on them

Religious people sorry for sins but cannot live up to standards..go to Jesus to cover the gaps cannot see true self righteousness living independent of God, others see rule-breaking, not as rebellion and self-salvation.

GOSPEL FAITH JUSTIFICATION IS BY FAITH ALONE BUT ALWAYS LEAD TO CHANGE
