1.	What are the three main issues in our lives that tend to obstruct our path to spiritual transformation? Can you share which of the three do you struggle with most in your life?
2.	Why is it important to identify which of these or may be all of them play a role in our progress in the faith?
3.	Compare and contrast the love of the world vs the love of God , why is the love of the world an illogical disordered love?
4.	Soren Kierkergaard wrote "What we call worldliness simply consists of such people who, if one may so express it, pawn themselves to the world. They use their abilities, amass wealth, carry out worldly enterprises, make prudent calculations, etc., and perhaps are mentioned in history, but they are not themselves. In a spiritual sense they have no self." How do we loose ourselves if we pursue an identity based on anyone or anything other than Christ?
