National LGBTQ Perception Study 2022

August – November 2022

An electronic survey was carried out from August to November 2022 amongst Christians in Malaysia concerning the perception of LGBTQ issues in the Malaysian context.

The survey collected a total of 1391 respondents comprising major Christian denominations such as Roman Catholics, Pentecostals, Methodists, Baptists, Lutherans, Presbyterians, and also independent churches. Over 45% of the respondents were below 40 years of age. Here are some of the key findings of this survey:

- Majority of heterosexuals do not accept LGBTQ identity. Yet, there is still a small minority that is open to LBGTQ identity.
- Only 16% of the participants agree (and 15.06% are unsure) that a confessing LGBTQ person is acceptable to be part of the clergy, pastoral staff or church leader.
- A substantial majority affirmed that the Bible does not permit LGBTQ. However, almost 23% of the participants believe that the Scripture has been misinterpreted by the church to forbid homosexual practices.
- Over 11% agree, and 14% are unsure that a person can be a Christian and a homosexual at the same time. Only 65% of the participants below the age of 40 disagree with the same statement.

Gender by Design

Genesis 1

4 common views especially among younger people on LGBTQ+ identity :

²⁷ So God created mankind <u>in his own image</u>, <u>in the image of God</u> he created them; male and female he created them.





We find other sorts of couples, like the sun and the moon, morning and evening, day and night, the sea and the dry land, and plants and animals, before reaching the climactic couple, a man and a woman. In every pairing, each part belongs with the other, but neither is interchangeable.

That God created us male and female *has cosmic and enduring significance.* From start to finish, the biblical storyline—and design of creation itself—depends upon the distinction between male and female as different from one another yet fitted each for the other.





The Gospel in Creation

Biblical Typology Defined:

- Graeme Goldsworthy: Biblical typology is the interpretation of earlier events, persons, and institutions in biblical history as prefigurations or foreshadowings of later events, persons, and institutions, which are their fulfillment.
- Geerhardus Vos: The Old Testament types are not accidental or arbitrary, but are grounded in the purpose and counsel of God, who controls history and guides it towards its fulfillment in Christ.

Adam as a Type of Christ:

- Representative Head: Adam as the first man is a representative head, prefiguring Christ as the head of the new creation (Romans 5:14).
- Deep Sleep and Wounding: Adam's deep sleep and the wound from which Eve is formed prefigure Christ's death and the wound from which the Church is born (John 19:34).

Eve as a Type of the Church:

- Derived from Adam: Eve's origin from Adam's side symbolizes the Church being brought forth from Christ's sacrificial death.
- One Flesh Union: The marital union of Adam and Eve prefigures the spiritual union between Christ and the Church (Ephesians 5:31-32).
- D.A. Carson: Ephesians 5:31-32 makes explicit what is implicit in Genesis: that the relationship between husband and wife mirrors the relationship between Christ and the Church. The sacrificial love of Christ, who gave Himself up for His Bride, is the ultimate fulfillment of the marital union first established in the Garden of Eden.
