Truth 1


God calls believers to work wholeheartedly as a reflection of our faith.

(Ephesian 6:5-7)

Slaves, obey your earthly masters with respect and fear, and with sincerity of heart, just as you would obey Christ.





1 Thessalonians 4:11b


11 and to make it your ambition to lead a quiet life: You should mind your own business and work with your hands, just as we told you,

While there is a general positive correlation, the relationship is not always linear, and other factors can significantly influence overall well-being.


