USE 2 DAY – HEBREW DEFINITION OF DAY

USE 3: INDEFINITE PERIOD OF TIME

USE 4. DAY = PERIOD OR ERA


Genesis 2:4 (ESV) These are the generations of the heavens and the earth when they were created, in <u>the day</u> that the LORD God made the earth and the heavens.

ANALOGICAL USE OF THE WORD "DAY"





4 USES OF THE WORD DAY

① God called the light Day, and the darkness he called Night (Genesis 1:5 ESV)…qualitative

- ② And there was evening and there was morning, the first day (Genesis 1:5B ESV) .. 24hr
- ③ And on the seventh day God finished his work that he had done, and he rested on the seventh day from all his work that he had done (Genesis 2:2 ESV) …never ending
- (4) These are the generations of the heavens and the earth when they were created, in the **day** that the Lord God made the earth and the heavens (Genesis 2.4



THE LOCK HAS 10 DIALS



1: 10,000,000,000 possible combinations

If you live to 100 years old and sample one combination every 10 seconds no breaks 3% of total possible combinations

Hence more likely a random search will fail than it will succeed
