

SETS THE STAGE FOR UNDERSTANDING SACRIFICE.

Leviticus 17:11-12 (ESV) For the life of the flesh is in the blood, and I have given it for you on the altar to make atonement for your souls, for it is the blood that makes atonement by the life. 12 Therefore I have said to the people of Israel, No. person among you shall eat blood, neither shall any stranger who sojourns among you eat blood.

- Infuse into society sense that human life is sacred


GIFT OF GOVERNMENT


IMAGE OF GOD


RAINBOW ASSOCIATED WITH GOD'S PRESENCE

- Ezekiel 1:28 Like the appearance of the bow that is in the cloud on the day of rain, so was the appearance of the brightness all around.

THE RAINBOW

COMMITMENT TO CREATION

Genesis 8:21-22 (ESV) And when the LORD smelled the pleasing aroma, the LORD said in his heart, "I will never again curse the ground because of man, for the intention of man's heart is evil from his youth. Neither will I ever again strike down every living creature as I have done. 22 While the earth remains, seedtime and harvest, cold and heat, summer and winter, day and night, shall not cease."

God's assessment of our moral condition is not improved by the flood. He is not so naïve as to think Noah and his descendants are without sin.

NOAH SINS RIGHT AFTER FLOOD

Genesis 9:20-21 (ESV) Noah began to be a man of the soil, and he planted a vineyard. 21 He drank of the wine and became <u>drunk</u> and lay uncovered in his tent.

THE FATE OF CREATION STILL LINKED TO MAN

Romans 8:19-21 (ESV) For the creation waits with eager longing for the revealing of the sons of God. 20 For the creation was subjected to futility, not willingly, but because of him who subjected it, in hope 21 that the creation itself will be set free from its bondage to corruption and obtain the freedom of the glory of the children of God.

CREATION BELONGS TO GOD







SIN RESURFACES


Genesis 9:18-21 (ESV) The sons of Noah who went forth from the ark were Shem, Ham, and Japheth. (Ham was the father of Canaan.) 19 These three were the sons of Noah, and from these the people of the whole earth were dispersed.

20 Noah began to be a man of the soil, and he planted a vineyard. 21 He drank of the wine and became drunk and lay uncovered in his tent.

Genesis 9:22-23 (ESV) And Ham, the father of Canaan, saw the nakedness of his father and told his two brothers outside. 23 Then Shem and Japheth took a garment, laid it on both their shoulders, and walked backward and covered the nakedness of their father. Their faces were turned backward, and they did not see their father's nakedness.

PROBLEMATIC PHRASE

Saw the nakedness of his father



Saw the physical nakedness and mocked him

Incest with mother

Sodomised

SAW THE PHYSICAL NAKEDNESS AND MOCKED HIM

Pros

- Plain meaning of the word···saw means observe and has no sexual connotation
- also told his brothers didn't cover him up compare with brothers
- Shem and Japheth walked back wards to avoid seeing naked Noah and covered him
- Description of sexual misconduct in Genesis 19:5, 30-35; 34:2 straight forward and not euphemistically done

SAW THE PHYSICAL NAKEDNESS AND MOCKED HIM

Pros

- Ham's sin was not seeing his father's nakedness but unspoken delight in it Hab 2:15
- In ancient world insulting one's parents extremely serious and warranted death penalty. also indicated contempt for God who instituted the order in creation

SAW THE PHYSICAL NAKEDNESS AND MOCKED HIM

Cons

- It is more than that because. 24 When Noah awoke from his wine and knew what his youngest son had done to him,
- It was something that Noah would have known was done to him hence it would be more than just being a victim of peeping tom
- The punishment seems out of proportion to the crime

INCEST WITH MOTHER

Pros

- Term is used in Lev 18:7 prohibits sex with mother and Lev 20: 17 man takes his sister
- Leviticus 18:7 (ESV) You shall not uncover the nakedness of your father, which is the nakedness of your mother; she is your mother, you shall not uncover her nakedness.

INCEST WITH MOTHER

Cons

Shem and Japheth walked back wards to avoid seeing naked Noah and covered him has nothing to do with incest

SODOMISED

Pros

- Homosexual act with Noah. Sodomy and left Noah naked who needed his other two sons to cover him
- Noah once awaken would have known he had been violated

SODOMISED

Cons

- nakedness 'and' to uncover (gala) nakedness 'are used of heterosexual actions, not homosexual encounters
- Lev 20:17 "If a man takes his sister, a daughter of his father or a daughter of his mother, and sees her nakedness, and she sees his nakedness, it is a disgrace, and they shall be cut off in the sight of the children of their people

LESSONS FROM NOAH'S DRUNKENESS



- Noah's lack of self-control was an occasion for Ham to sin
- Honor parents
- Children have individual wills
- God of grace

Genesis 9:24-26 (ESV) When Noah awoke from his wine and knew what his youngest son had done to him, 25 he said,







SUBJUGATION OF CAANAN BY ISRAEL




FLOOD IS FORESHADOW OF FINAL JUDGMENT

2 Peter 3:5-7 (ESV) For they deliberately overlook this fact, that the heavens existed long ago, and the earth was formed out of water and through water by the word of God, 6 and that by means of these the world that then existed was deluged with water and perished. 7 But by the same word the heavens and earth that now exist are stored up for fire, being kept until the day of judgment and destruction of the ungodly.

ARK IS FORESHADOW OF SALVATION

1 Peter 3:20-21 (ESV) while the ark was being prepared, in which a few, that is, eight persons, were brought safely through water. 21 Baptism, which corresponds to this, now saves you, not as a removal of dirt from the body but as an appeal to God for a good conscience, through the resurrection of Jesus Christ
