



Peace


There can only be peace where there is righteousness

Hebrews 7:3 (ESV) He is without father or mother or genealogy, having neither beginning of days nor end of life, but resembling the Son of God he continues a priest forever.

Hebrews 7:4 See how great this man was to whom Abraham the natriarch gave a tenth of the spoils!

BY EXTENSION JESUS IS SUPERIOR

Hebrews 7:9-10 One might even say that Levi himself, who receives tithes, paid tithes through Abraham, 10 for he was still in the loins of his ancestor when Melchizedek met him.

DIRECT APPOINTMENT

Hebrews 7:21-22 (ESV) but this one was made a priest with an oath by the one who said to him:

"The Lord has sworn

and will not change his mind,

'You are a priest forever.' "

22 This makes Jesus the guarantor of a better covenant.

Psalms 110:4 The LORD has sworn and will not change his mind, "You are a priest forever after the order of Melchizedek."










CLASS REUNION

THE BACKGROUND

Jeremiah 34:18-20 And the men who transgressed my covenant and did not keep the terms of the covenant that they made before me, I will make them like the calf that they cut in two and passed between its parts—the officials of Judah, the officials of Jerusalem, the eunuchs, the priests, and all the people of the land who passed between the parts of the calf.

ONLY GOD PASSED BETWEEN THE ANIMAL PARTS

17. When the sun had gone down and it was dark, behold, a smoking fire pot and a flaming torch passed between these pieces

ONLY GOD PASSED BETWEEN THE ANIMAL PARTS

- 1. God is accountable for the promises and penalty of the covenant if He fails
- 2. Abraham does not pass through means when he fails God is accountable and will pay the price



CONFIRMATION OF THE COVENANT

Genesis 15:18-21 (ESV) On that day the LORD made a covenant with Abram, saying, "To your offspring I give this land, from the river of Egypt to the great river, the river Euphrates, 19 the land of the Kenites, the Kenizzites, the Kadmonites, 20 the Hittites, the Perizzites, the Rephaim, 21 the Amorites, the Canaanites, the Girgashites and the Jebusites.
