COVENANT RENEWAL

Genesis 26:24-25 And the LORD appeared to him the same night and said, "I am the God of Abraham your father. Fear not, for I am with you and will bless you and multiply your offspring for my servant Abraham's sake." 25 So he built an altar there and called upon the name of the LORD and pitched his tent there. And there Isaac's servants dug a well.

The Blessing

Divine Sovereignty: Overturn Primogeniture

Genesis 25:22-23 (ESV) The children struggled together within her, and she said, "If it is thus, why is this happening to me?" So she went to inquire of the LORD. 23 And the LORD said to her, "Two nations are in your womb, and two peoples from within you shall be divided; the one shall be stronger than the other, the older shall serve the younger."

HUMAN RESPONSIBILITY

Genesis 25:33-34 (ESV) Jacob said, "Swear to me now." So he swore to him and sold his birthright to Jacob. 34 Then Jacob gave Esau bread and lentil stew, and he ate and drank and rose and went his way. Thus Esau despised his birthright.

UNGODLY ESAU

Genesis 26:34-35 (ESV) When Esau was forty years old, he took Judith the daughter of Beeri the Hittite to be his wife, and Basemath the daughter of Elon the Hittite, 35 and they made life bitter for Isaac and Rebekah.

Genesis 27:28-29 ESV May God give you of the dew of heaven and of the fatness of the earth and plenty of grain and wine. 29 Let peoples serve you, and nations bow down to you. Be lord over your brothers, and may your mother's sons bow down to you.

HEBREWS 11:20-22 BLESSING IS ACT OF FAITH OF PARTRIACH

- 20 **By faith** Isaac invoked future blessings on Jacob and Esau.
- 21 <u>By faith</u> Jacob, when dying, blessed each of the sons of Joseph, bowing in worship over the head of his staff.
- 22 <u>By faith Joseph</u>, at the end of his life, made mention of the exodus of the Israelites and gave directions concerning his bones.

- David instead of his 7 older brothers



He cannot fight it as he freely dispensed bless ing out of his own selfish will




The end does not justify the means

Genesis 27:41 Now Esau hated Jacob because of the blessing with which his father had blessed him, and Esau said to himself, "The days of mourning for my father are approaching; then I will kill my brother Jacob

RIFT BETWEEN MOTHER AND SON

Genesis 28:6 Now Esau saw that Isaac had blessed Jacob and sent him away to Paddan- aram to take a wife from there, and that as he blessed him he directed him, "You must not take a wife from the Canaanite women, " 7 and that Jacob had obeyed his father and his mother and gone to Paddan-aram. 8 So when Esau saw that the Canaanite women did not please Isaac his father, 9 Esau went to Ishmael and took as his wife, besides the wives he had, Mahalath the daughter of Ishmael, Abraham's son, the sister of Nebaioth

- She would never again see Jacob




JACOB WITH LABAN'S FLOCK - JUSEPE DE RIBERA - C.1632

JACOB'S DREAM: FROM DECEPTION TO DESTINY


- A. God comes to us when we are at our lowest





Similar language for Babel








Genesis 28:16-19 (ESV) Then Jacob awoke from his sleep and said, "Surely the LORD is in this place, and I did not know it." 17 And he was <u>afraid</u> and said, "How <u>awesome</u> is this place! This is none other than the <u>house of God</u>, and this is the gate of heaven."

18 So early in the morning Jacob took the stone that he had put under his head and set it up for a <u>pillar and</u> <u>poured oil on the top of it.</u> 19 He called the name of that place Bethel, but the name of the city was Luz at

1. JACOB'S RESPONSE IS TRANSACTIONAL GOD JACOB

God's offer is unconditional

13b The land on which you lie I will give to you and to your offspring. 14 Your offspring shall be like the dust of the earth, and you shall spread abroad to the west and to the east and to the north and to the south, and in you and your offspring shall all the **families** of the earth be blessed. 15 Behold, I am with you and will keep you wherever you go, and will bring you back to this land. For I will not leave you until I have done what I have promised you."

Jacob's response is conditional

20 **If God** will be with me and will keep me in this way that I go, and will give me bread to eat and clothing to wear, 21 so that I come again to my father's house in peace, then the LORD shall be my God, 22 and this stone, which I have set up for a pillar, shall be God's house. And of all that you give me <u>I will give</u> a full tenth to you."

Jacobs promises

- 1) "If God will be with me. . ." (v. 20a);
- 2) "give me food . . . clothes" (v. 20b); and
- 3) "I return safely to my father's house

The asaity of God

Jacobs promises

- 1) "the LORD will be my God" (v. 21b);
- 2) recognition of "God's house" (v. 22a);
- 3) "I will give you a tenth" (v. 22b).





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SIGNS OF TRANSACTIONAL FAITH

- Anger or Disappointment when it does not go your way
- Prayer life dominated by needs
- Commitment leveraged to fulfil our desires
- Guilt You wonder if God is punishing you when something bad happens
- You think God demands excellence in all things
- You are doing instead of being
- Faith becomes a tool
- Assumes you are in co-equal relationship
- Blessings become a right
