JACOB COMMANDED TO LEAVE

Gen 31:3 Then the Lord said to Jacob, "Return to the land of your fathers and to your kindred, and I will be with you."

JACOB RETURNS

Gen 32: 1 Jacob went on his way, and the ange Revelation comes with faith when Jacob saw them he said, "This is God's camp!" So he called the name of that place Mahanaim.

DANGEROUS CALLING OF GOD

Genesis 27:4 Now Esau hated Jacob because of the blessing with which his father had blessed him, and Esau said to himself, "The days of mourning for my father are approaching; then I will kill my brother Jacob.

WHAT IS JACOB'S PLAN TO MEET HIS BROTHER ESAU?

Gen 32: 3 And Jacob sent messengers before him to Esau his brother in the land of Seir, the country of Edom, 4 instructing them, "Thus you shall say to my lord Esau: Thus says your servant Jacob, 'I have sojourned with Laban and stayed until now. 5 I have oxen, donkeys, flocks, male servants, and female servants. I have sent to tell my lord, in order that I may find favor in your sight.'"

OUR IDENTIFICATION

Romans 8:14-17 (ESV) For all who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God. 15 For you did not receive the <u>spirit of slavery to fall back into fear</u>, but you have received the Spirit of adoption as sons, by whom we cry, "Abba! Father!" 16 The Spirit himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, 17 and if children, then heirs—heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ, provided we suffer with him in order that we may also be glorified with him.

If <u>God is for us, who can be against us</u>? 32 He who did not spare his own Son but gave him up for us all, how will he not also with him graciously give us all things? 33 Who shall bring any charge against God's elect? C. SENSE OF UNWORTHINESS OF GOD'S GRACE AND FAITHFULNESS

D. PETITION FOR DELIVERANCE BASED ON HIS PROMISES-COVENANTAL FAITHFULNESS

Not based on any of our intrinsic value but on the value of His promises

11 Please deliver me from the hand of my **brother**, from the hand of Esau, for I fear him, that he may come and attack me, the mothers with the children. 12 But you said, 'I will surely do you good, and make your offspring as the sand of the sea, which cannot be numbered for multitude. '"

E. EXPRESSION OF EMOTION-FEAR

11 Please deliver me from the hand of my brother, from the hand of Esau, <u>for I fear him, that he</u> <u>may come and attack me, the mothers with the</u> <u>children</u>.




Our strength lies in our tenacity in hanging on and depending on Him We do not fight to overcome circumstances or enemies but we fight to hold on to our faith in Him.


