

18 Of his own vill he brought us forth by the word of truth, that we should be a kin d of <u>first-fruits</u> of his creatures.






### **CORROBORATION WITH NT**




### PARABLE OF THE SOWER



- Cannot admit moral failure










## RECEIVED WORD WITH MEEKNESS




# GOSPEL OF GRACE CAUSES GROWTH
