


MIRROR ANALOGY

THE CHRISTIAN AND THE POOR

- We should not discriminate against the poor because God regards them highly
- 2) Our discrimination insults the poor
- 3) It is illogical to honor the very people who usually do you harm and persecute believers
- 4) Discrimination against the poor breaks the heart of God's law
- 5) We cannot pick and choose which laws to obey
- 6) How we treat the poor is a life and death matter
- 7) How we treat the poor is a function of our faith

Aorist imperative

OT BACKGROUND



Materially poor





DECEPTION


James 1:16-17 (FSV) Do not **be deceived** my beloved brothers. 17 Deceived about God's character ift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights

James 1: Deceived self in only hearing and not acting hearers only, <u>deceiving yourselves</u>. 23 For if anyone is a hearer of the word and not a doer, he is like a man who looks intently at his natural face in a mirror.



POOR DESERVE GREATER HONOR

1 Corinthians 12:22-25 On the contrary, the parts of the body that seem to be weaker are indispensable, 23 and on those parts of the body that we think less honorable we bestow the greater honor, and our unpresentable parts are treated with greater modesty, 24 which our more presentable parts do not require. But God has so composed the body, giving greater honor to the part that lacked it, 25 that there may be no division in the body, but that the members may have the same care for one another.






BASIS OF FAIRNESS




SERIOUS MATTER

Social injustice to the poor is just as bad a murder or adultery




6. HOW WE TREAT THE POOR IS A LIFE AND DEATH MATTER



7. HOW WE TREAT THE POOR IS A FUNCTION OF OUR FAITH

James 2:14-17 What good is it, my brothers, if someone says he has faith but does not have works? Can that faith save him? 15 If a brother or sister is **poorly clothed and lacking** in daily food, 16 and one of you says to them, "Go in peace, be warmed and filled," without giving them the things needed for the body, what good is that? 17 So also faith by itself, if it does not have works, is dead


