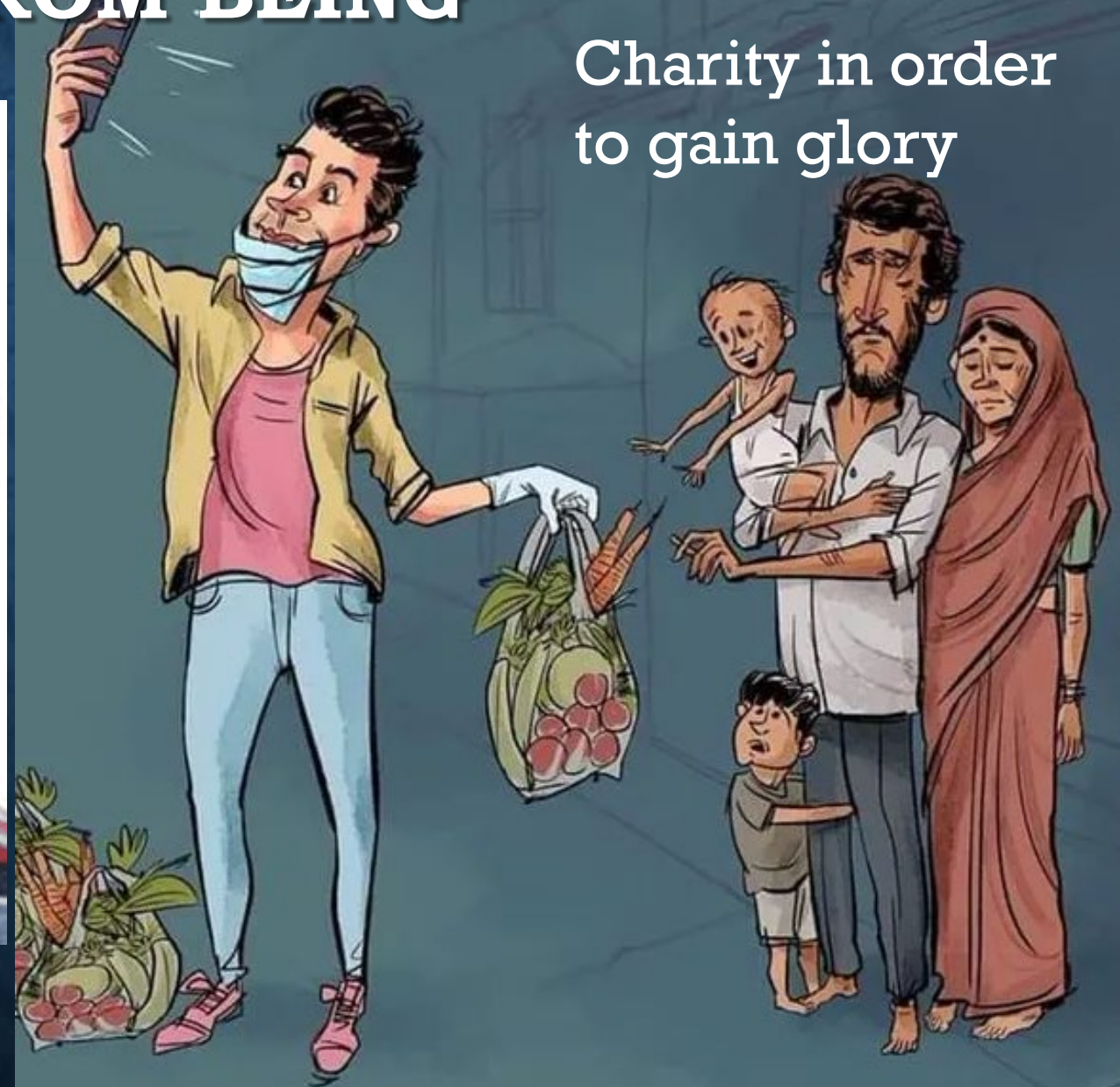

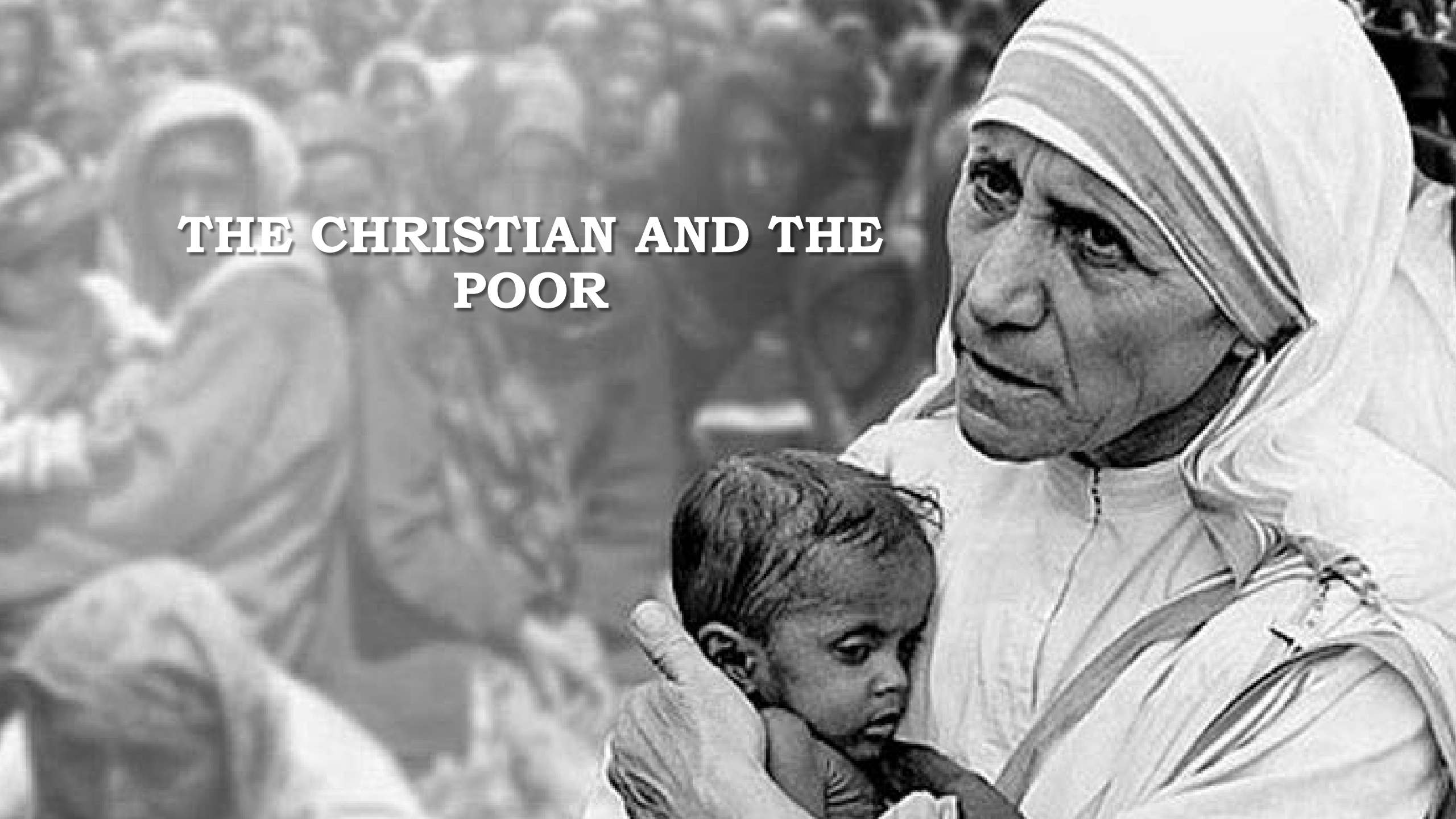
MIRROR ANALOGY

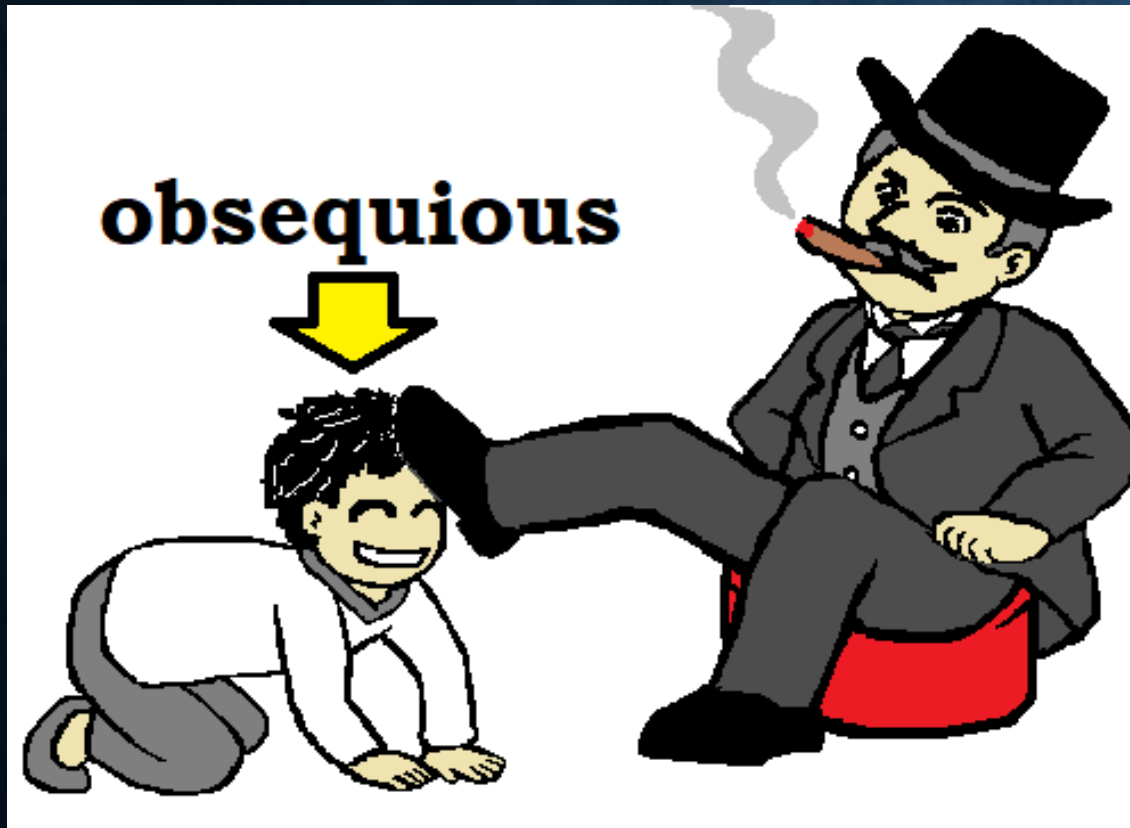
DECEPTION

POOR DESERVE GREATER HONOR

1 Corinthians 12:22-25 On the contrary, the parts of the body that seem to be weaker are indispensable, 23 and on those parts of the body that we think less honorable we bestow the greater honor, and our unpresentable parts are treated with greater modesty, 24 which our more presentable parts do not require. But God has so composed the body, giving greater honor to the part that lacked it, 25 that there may be no division in the body, but that the members may have the same care for one another.

James 2:10-11 For whoever keeps the whole law but fails in one point has become accountable for all of it. 11 For he who said, “Do not commit adultery,” also said, “Do not murder.” If you do not commit adultery but do murder, you have become a transgressor of the law

MURDERERS –LITERAL OR METAPHORICAL?

Isaiah 1:21-23 How the faithful city has become a whore, she who was full of justice! **Righteousness** lodged in her, but now **murderers**.

Everyone loves a bribe and runs after gifts. They do not bring justice to the fatherless, and the widow's cause does not come to them

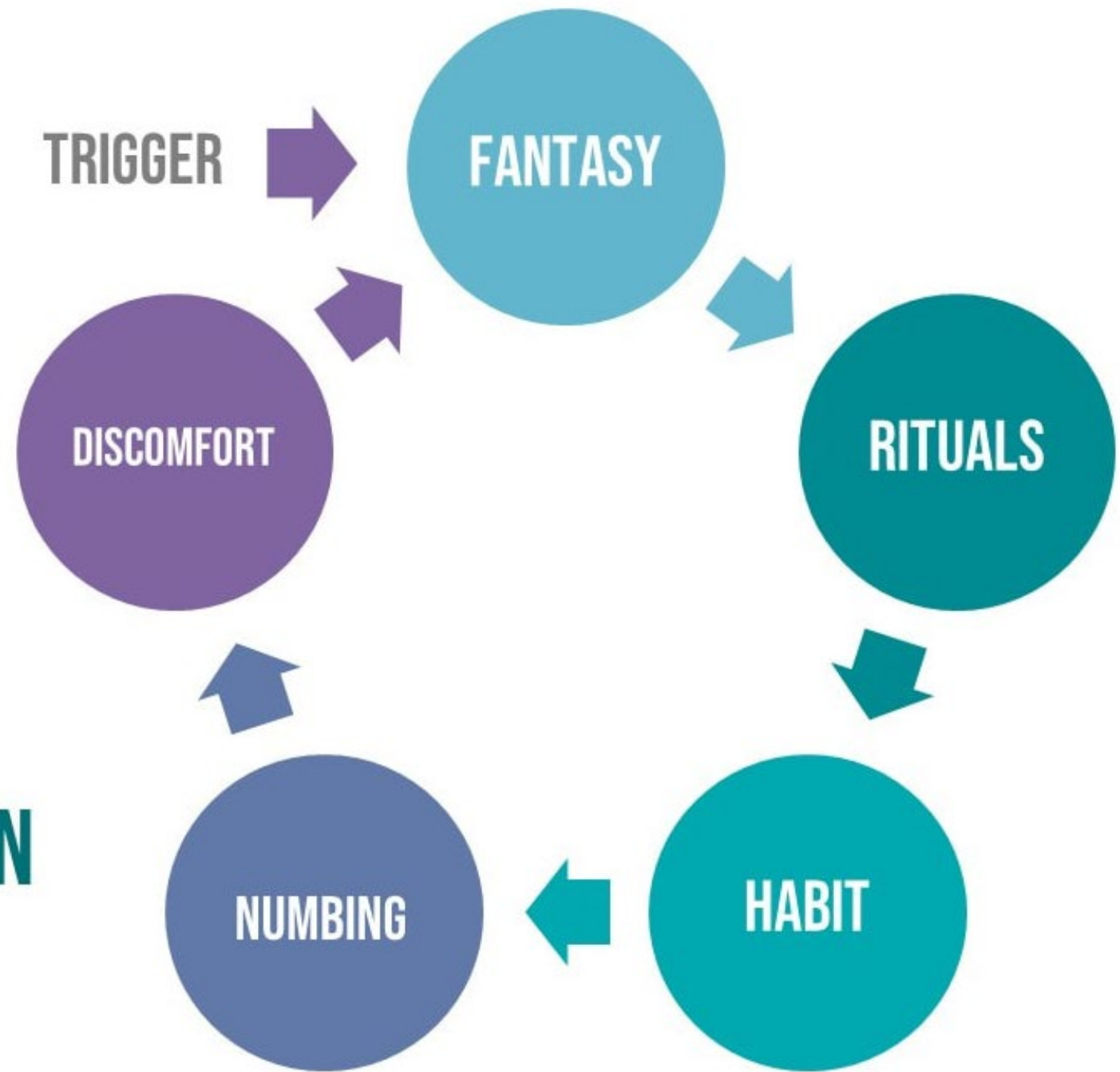

Can that faith save him? 15 If a brother or sister is poorly clothed and lacking in daily food, 16 and one of you says to them, “Go in peace, be warmed and filled,” without giving them the things needed for the body, what good is that? 17 So also faith by itself, if it does not have works, is dead

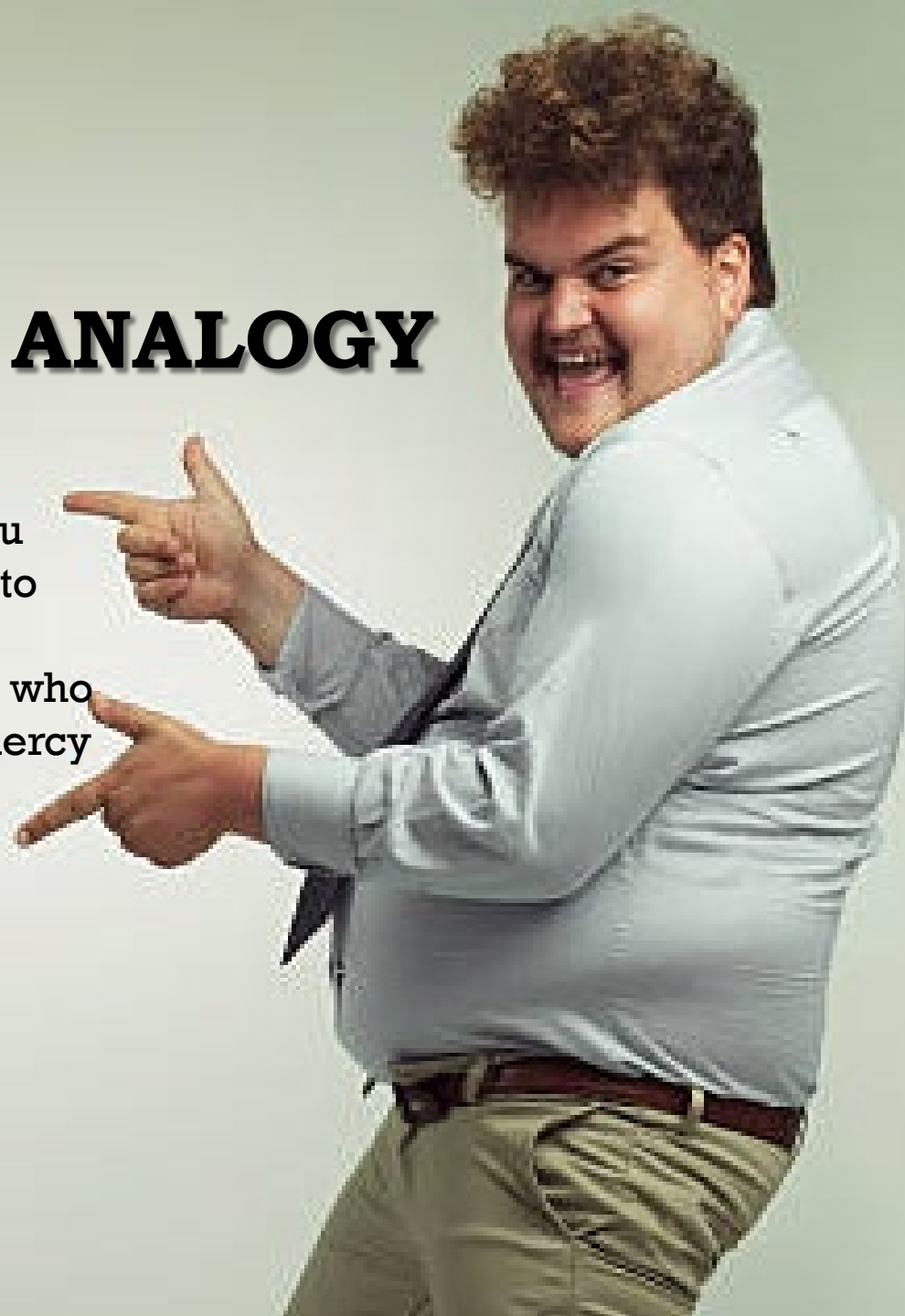
