

- Gossip




Deuteronomy 9:6-8 (ESV) Know, therefore, that the LORD your God is not giving you this good land to possess because of your righteousness, for you are a stubborn people. 7 Remember and do not forget how you provoked the LORD your God to wrath in the wilderness. From the day you came out of the land of Egypt until you came to this place, you have been rebellious against the LORD. 8 Even at Horeb you provoked the LORD to wrath, and the LORD was so angry with you that he was ready to destroy you.

Romans 1:18 (ESV) For the wrath of God s revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who by their unrighteousness suppress the truth.

Mark 3:3-5 (ESV) And he said to the man with the withered hand, "Come here." 4 And he said to them, "Is it lawful on the Sabbath to do good or to do harm, to save life or to kill?" But they were silent. 5 And he looked around at them with anger, grieved at their hardness of heart, and said to the man, "Stretch out your hand." He stretched it out, and his hand was restored.


JOURNAL OF PERSONALITY AND SOCIAL PSYCHOLOGY

HENRY KELLERMAN, A PSYCHOLOGIST

- 1. Anger has an aggressive drive. It's inborn.
- 2. Anger is expansive. It wants to get bigger.
- 3. Anger has explosive potential. It wants to burst forth.
- 4. Anger has an attack inclination. It wants to attack.
- 5. Anger has a confrontational inclination. It wants to get tough.
- 6. Anger has an entitled frame of mind. It feels it has the right to get tough.
- 7. Anger sees itself as an empowerment. It eliminates feelings of helplessness.

MEDITATION REMOVES ANGER RESTORES HOPE




BITTERNESS

"emotional state of feeling distressed disappointment from unmet expectations or having the perception of being treated unfairly and holding someone liable"





- Grievances to Yourself
- To the person
- To others—slander-prayer request
- Judging—passing sentence
- Wishes evil on a person
- Rejoice when they fall
- Actively retaliate in some cases



CONTRAST GOD WHO FORGIVES AND DOES NOT HOLD YOU LIABLE



HEART CHANGED FOREVER



Proverbs 18:21 (ESV) Death and life are in the power of the tongue, and those who love it will eat its fruits.


ACCOUNTABILITY
