



a man and his father go in to the same girl,so that my holy name is profaned;

LGBT ----NOT WORSE THAN GREED

MARTIN LUTHER

A man is generous because he trusts God and never doubts but that he will always have enough . In contrast a man is covetous and anxious because he does not trust God . Now faith is the master work man and motivating force behind the good work of generosity



(Twofold Center of Lutheran Ethics)

The command not to covet safeguards both the worship of the Lord and the well being of our neighbours


