



THE POINT OF OUR PREDESTINATION







- John 1:14And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the <u>only Son</u> from the Father,
- John 1:18 (ESV) 18 No one has ever seen God; the <u>only</u> God, who is at the Father's side, he has made him known.
- John 3:18 (ESV) Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the <u>only Son</u> of God.
- 1 John 4:9 (ESV) 9 In this the love of God was made manifest among us, that God sent his only Son into the world, so that we might live through him.

ROMAN ADOPTION

Adoption was to preserve the family as worshipping unit Unilateral Legal act by Father Expensive and costly by Father

ADOPTION-CHANGE OF STATUS NOT NATURE

- Needed male priest to lead in worship
- All debts are paid off
- Father responsibility for liabilities of the son
- Adoptee became the same person as the adopter.
- Heirs immediately as all family members held property jointly

TO BELIEVERS IN THYATHIRA





SUBJECTIVE ASSURANCE

Galatians 4:6-7 (ESV) And because you are sons, God has sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, crying, "Abba! Father!" 7 So you are no longer a slave, but a son, and if a son, then an heir through God.

CHANGE THE WAY WE THINK FEEL AND BEHAVE

Romans 8:14-16 (ESV) For all who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God. 15 For you did not receive the spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you have received the Spirit of adoption as sons, by REASSURANCE bba! Father!" 16 The Spirit himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God

EXPERIENCE



DISCIPLINE

Hebrews 12:6 For the Lord disciplines the one he loves, and chastises every son whom he receives." 7 It is for discipline that you have to endure. God is treating you as sons. For what son is there whom his father does not discipline? 8 If you are left without discipline, in which all have participated, then you are illegitimate children and not sons.



CONFIDENCE DUE TO THE EVIDENCE OF HIS INFLUENCE..HOLINESS

1 John 2:28-29 And now, little children, abide in him, so that when he appears we may have confidence and not shrink from him in shame at his coming. 29 If you know that he is righteous, you may be sure that everyone who practices righteousness has been born of him.


