What do you think?
- 4. Thomas was having a lot of trouble with his wife at home as they were fighting all the time. He kept insisting on his own way at home, would not do any house work whilst his wife had to keep house and a full time job and look after their kids. He then came across the verse 33 which promised peace and claimed it in prayer but still no peace and he concluded the bible gave false promises. How would you counsel him?
- 5. Timothy was a Christian faced with a dilemma at work. His boss wanted him to cover up some false invoices which he had put in but Timothy was the financial controller of the company. The boss told him that it was his company so he had to toe the line. The company was a public listed company of which the boss owned 20% share. Timothy refused and was sacked. There were lots of legal fees and suffering for Timothy and then he came across verse 33 and claimed it in prayer. Was it the right thing to pray about? How will God answer his prayer?
