How Jesus spoke the truth in love

John 4: 1-24

⁷ When a Samaritan woman came to draw water, Jesus said to her, “Will you give me a drink?” ⁸ (His disciples had gone into the town to buy food.)

⁹ The Samaritan woman said to him, “**You are a Jew and I am a Samaritan woman. How can you ask me for a drink?**” (For Jews do not associate with Samaritans.)

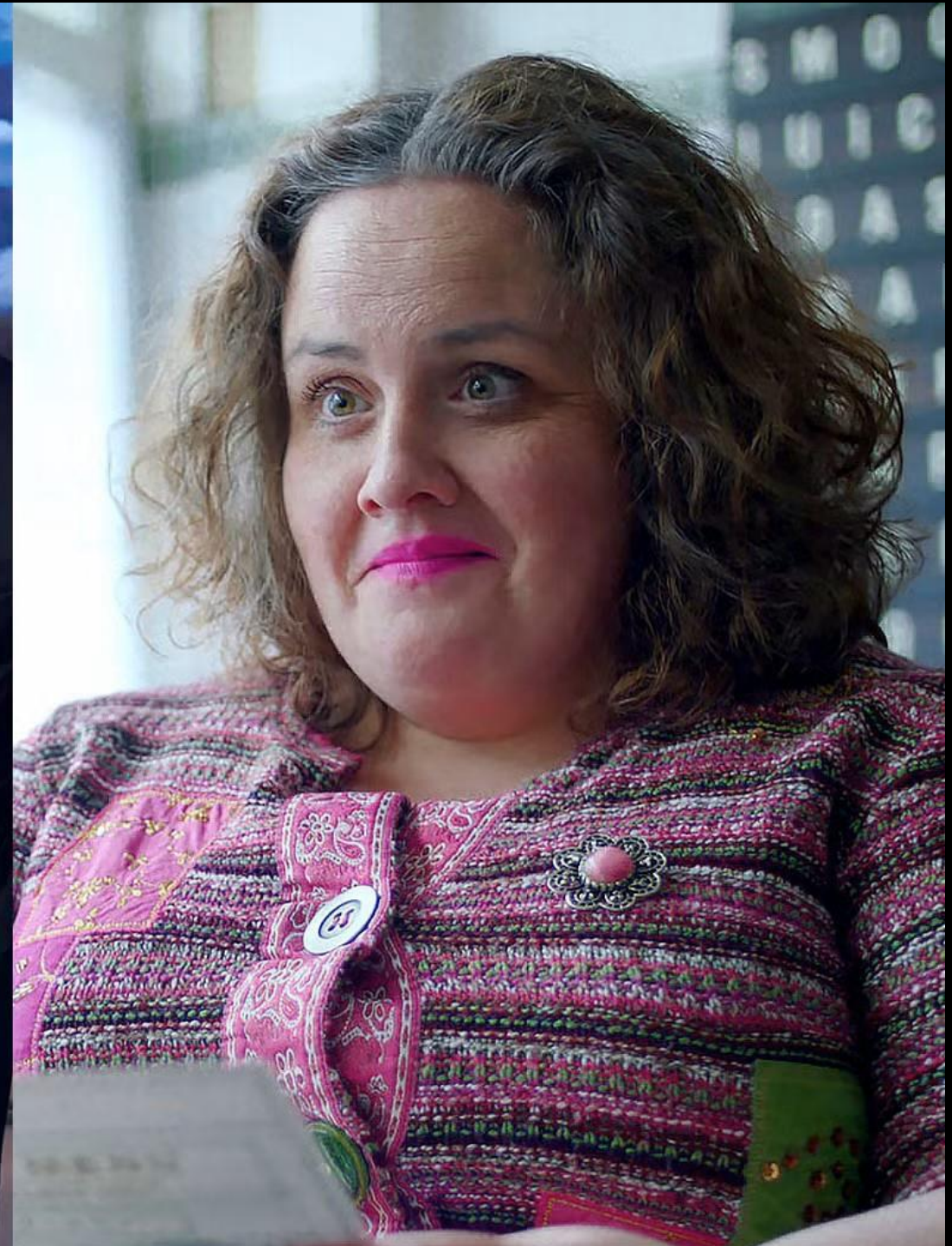

- We come together seeking to drink the living waters Christ offers
- We pour out living waters to Him and to each other by the prompting of the Holy Spirit
- **We allow God to speak His truth to us before we go and speak our version of truth to others**

How does God speak His truth to us this morning so we can be better at speaking the truth in love to others?
