





WHAT FALSE TEACHERS SOW

Galatians 6:11-12 (ESV) 11 See with what large letters I am writing to you with my own hand. 12 It is those who want to make a good showing in the flesh who would force vou to be circumcised, and only in order that they **may not be persecuted** for the cross of Christ.

THE OPPOSITE OF PAUL

Galatians 5:11-12 (ESV) 11 But if I, brothers, still preach circumcision, why am I still being persecuted. In that case the offense of the cross has been removed. 12 I wish those who unsettle you would emasculate themselves!

Galatians 4:17 ESV They make much of you, but for no good purpose. They want to shut you out, that




FALSE TEACHERS END GAME




A LOT OF US ARE LIKE PETER


